Section 1: Introduction

1.1 Introduction

HOLEX have commissioned a research project, funded by FETL, to present geographical reach of the existing adult community education offer. This covers participation by demographic factors of ethnicity, gender, age and skills level with the data being matched to other data sources such as indices of deprivation.

The primary data sources used within this report is the individualised learner record which records publicly funded learning in England. The data covers learning undertaking during the academic years between 2016/17 and 2018/19. The data was supplied by the Department for Education using the Office of National Statistics Secure Research Service. The figures presented in this report are rounded to the nearest 10 and any figure less than 10 has been suppressed.

The Community Learning section covers all learners and learning aims which are recorded under the community learning funding model. This includes all providers that deliver this provision (259 providers in 2018/19 of which 131 were local authorities). There are approximately 2,400 instances of community learning missing from the final data return for the 2017/18 academic year due to a submission error for three providers.

The Adult Education Budget section focuses on learners and learning aims funded via the Adult Education Budget excluding Community Learning. This section focuses on delivery by Local Authority Providers and only includes those which pass the funding qualifying period.

The table below summarises the number of learners/apprenticeships attending Local Authorities by funding model. The figures in brackets show the number of Local Authorities.

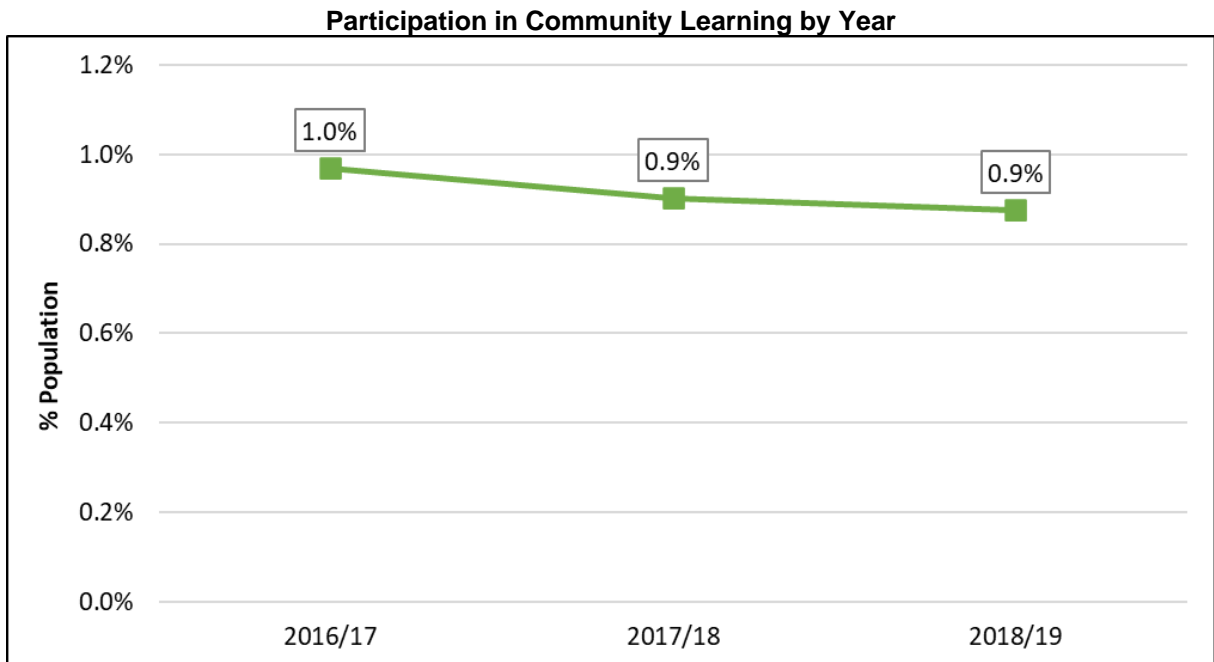

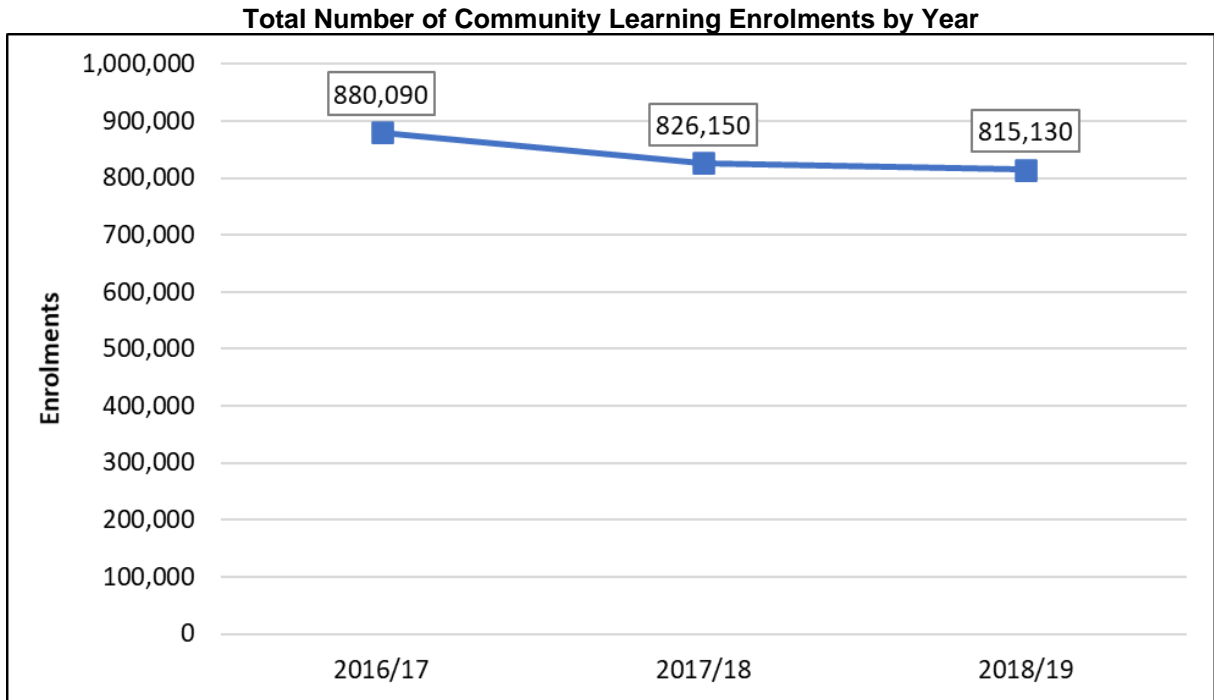

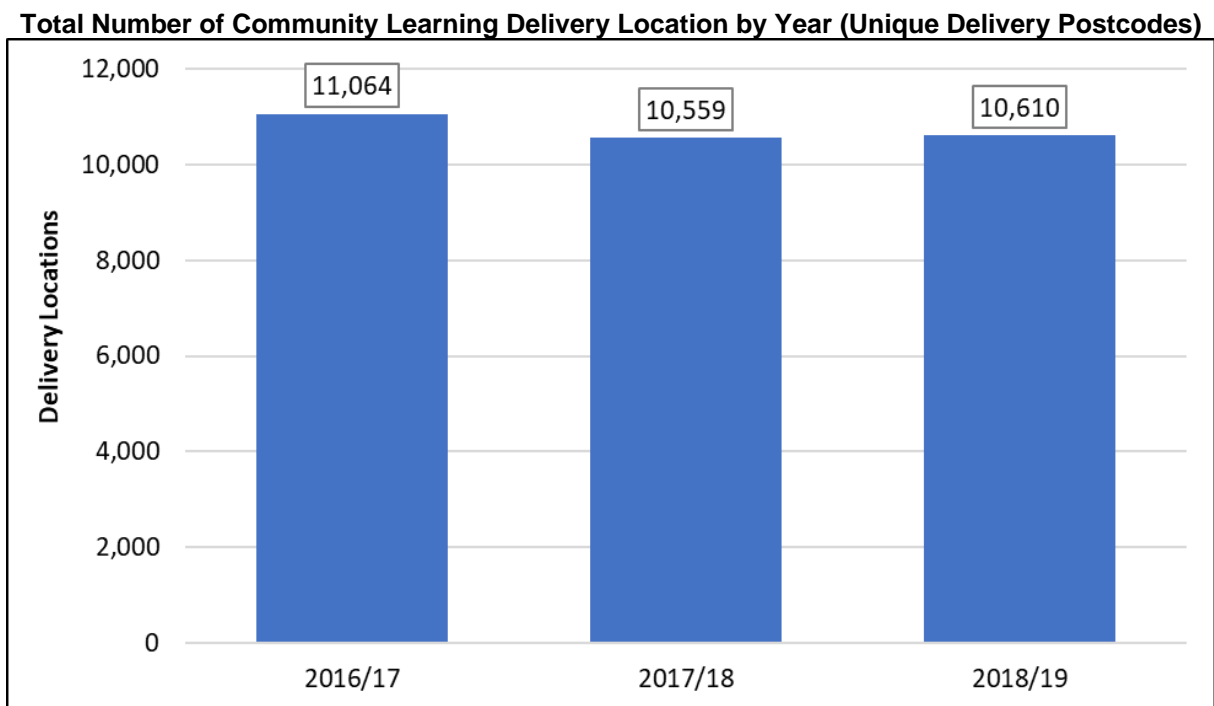

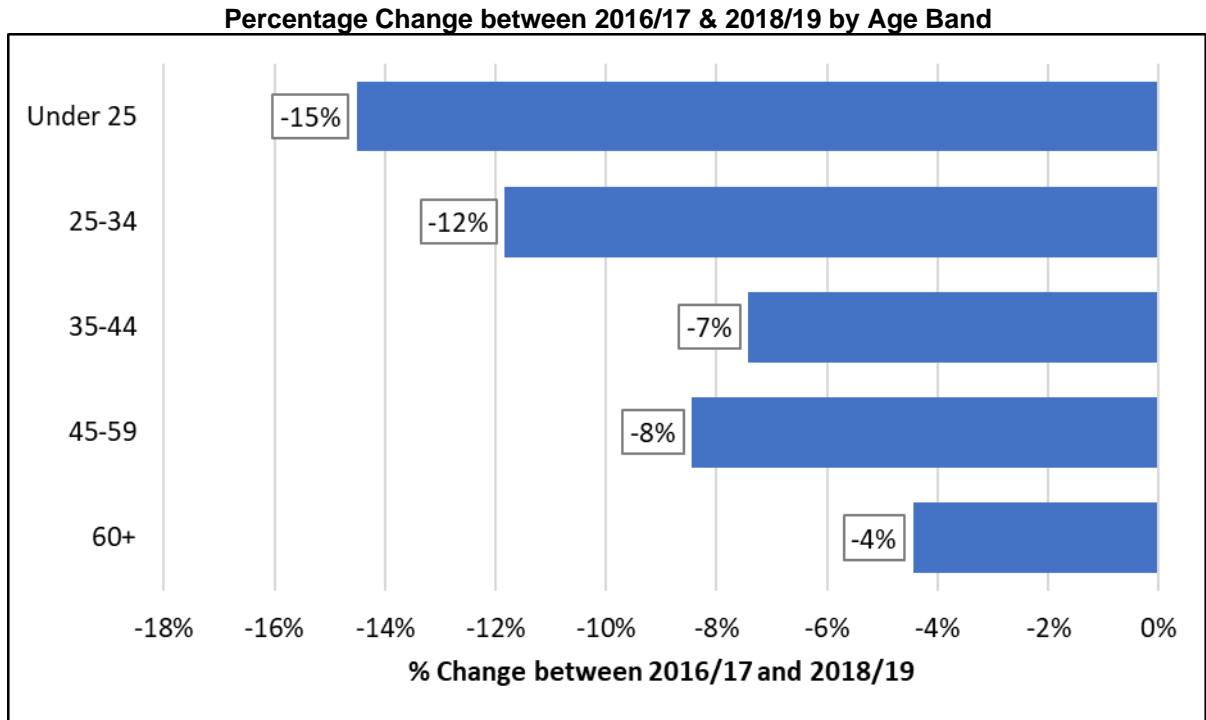

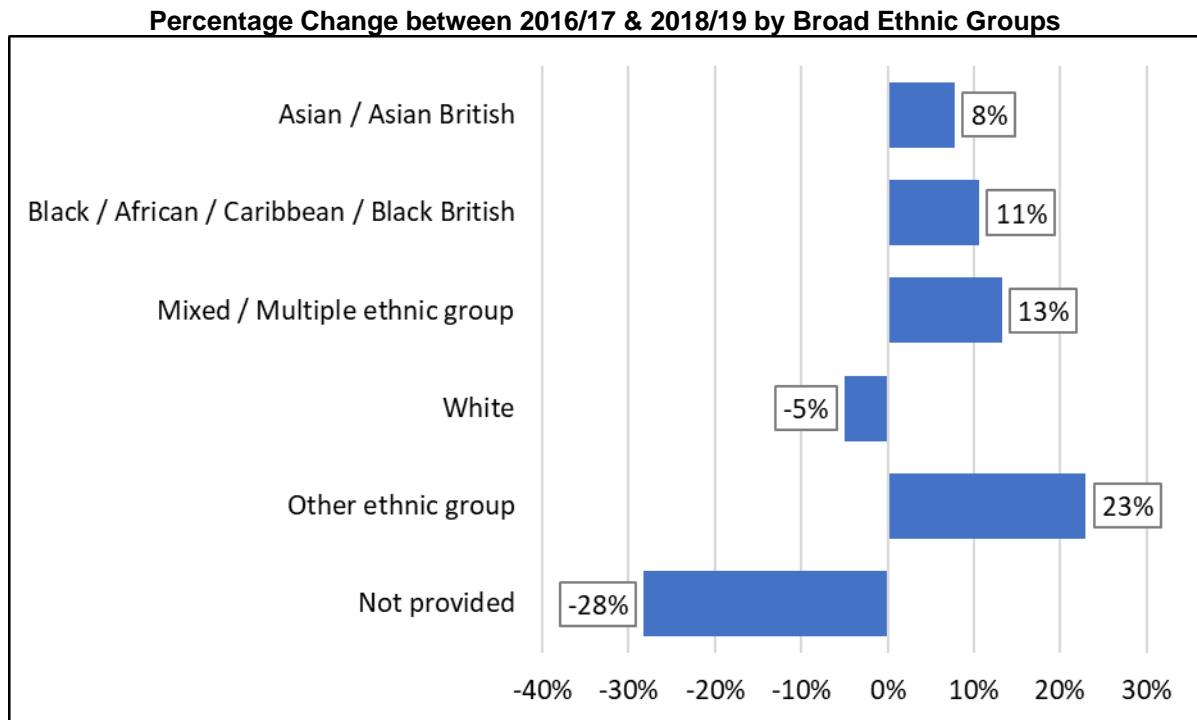

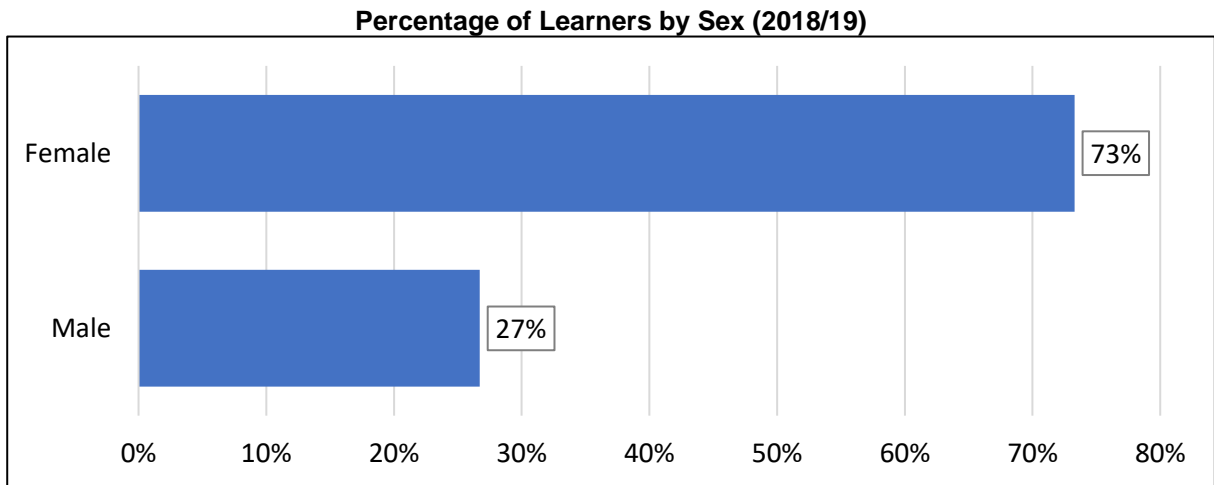

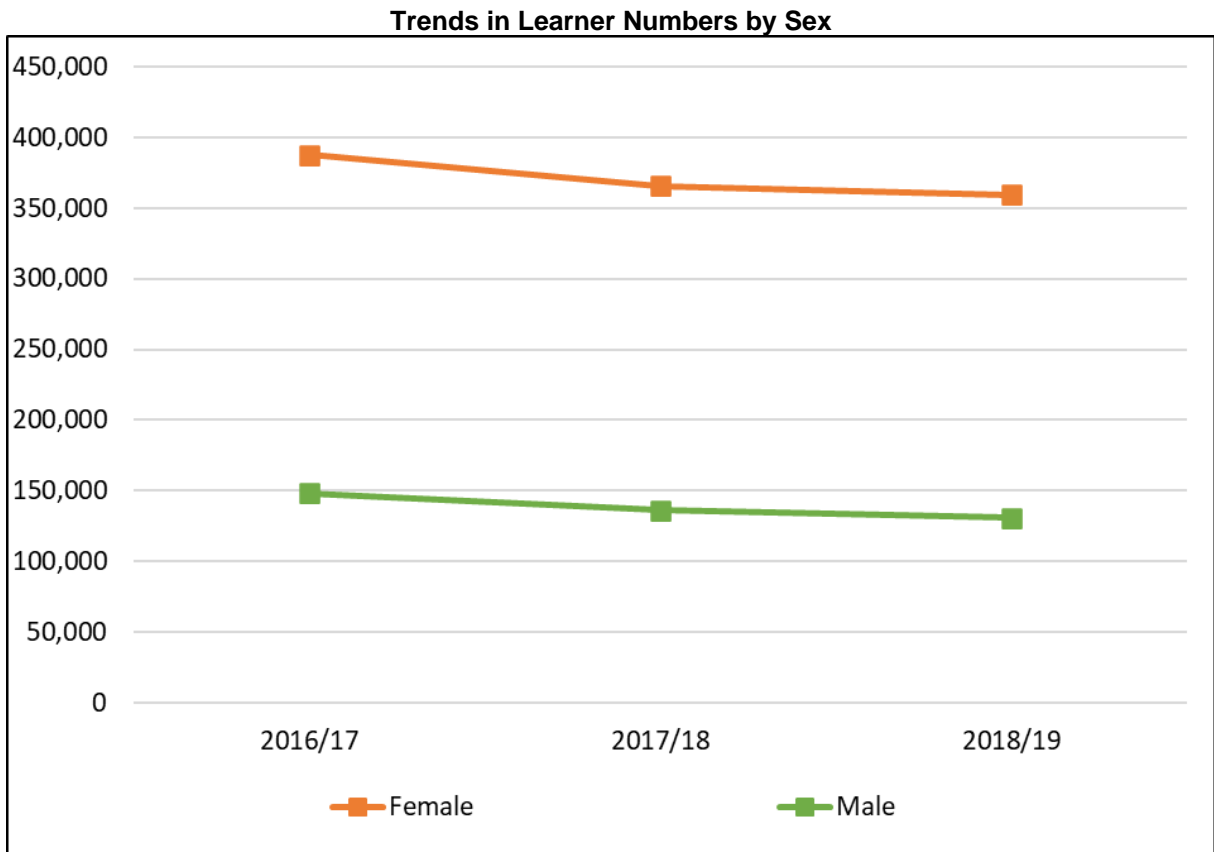

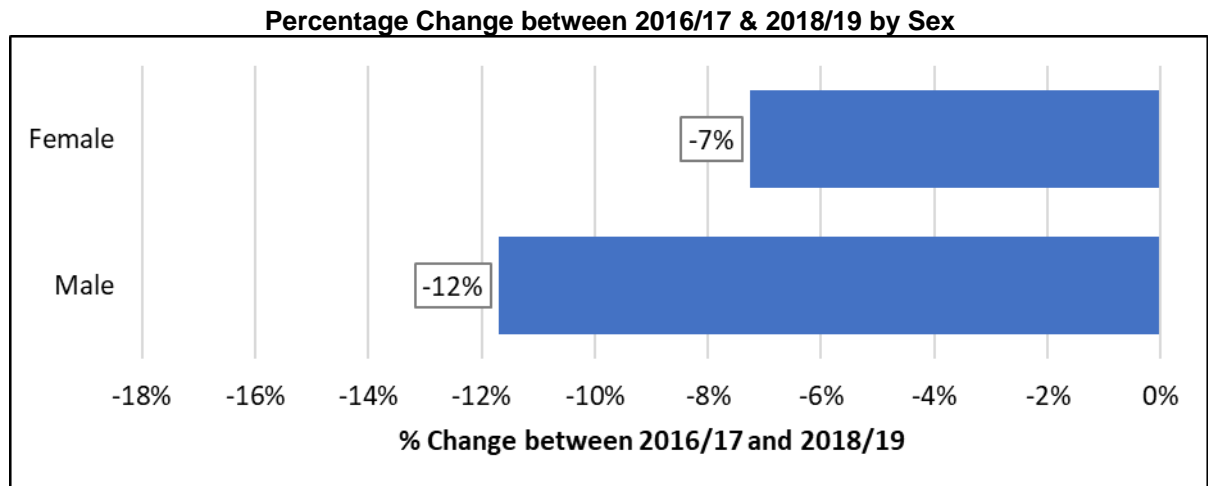

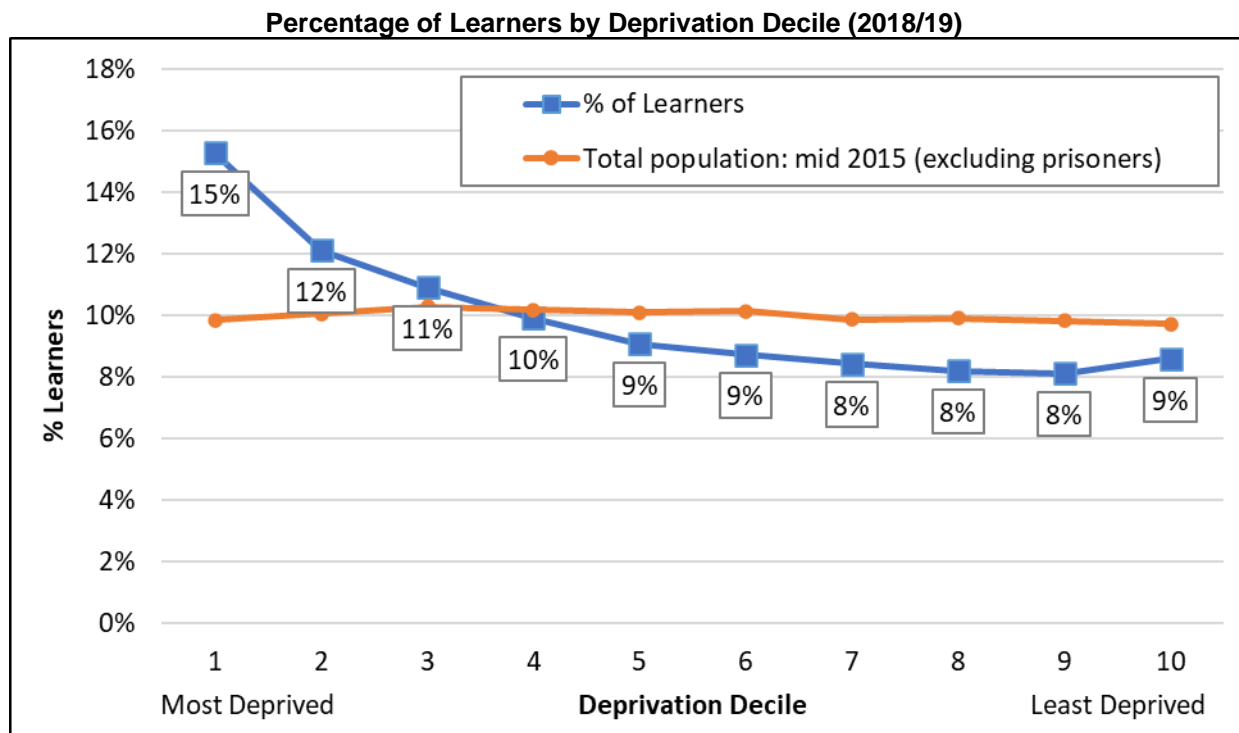

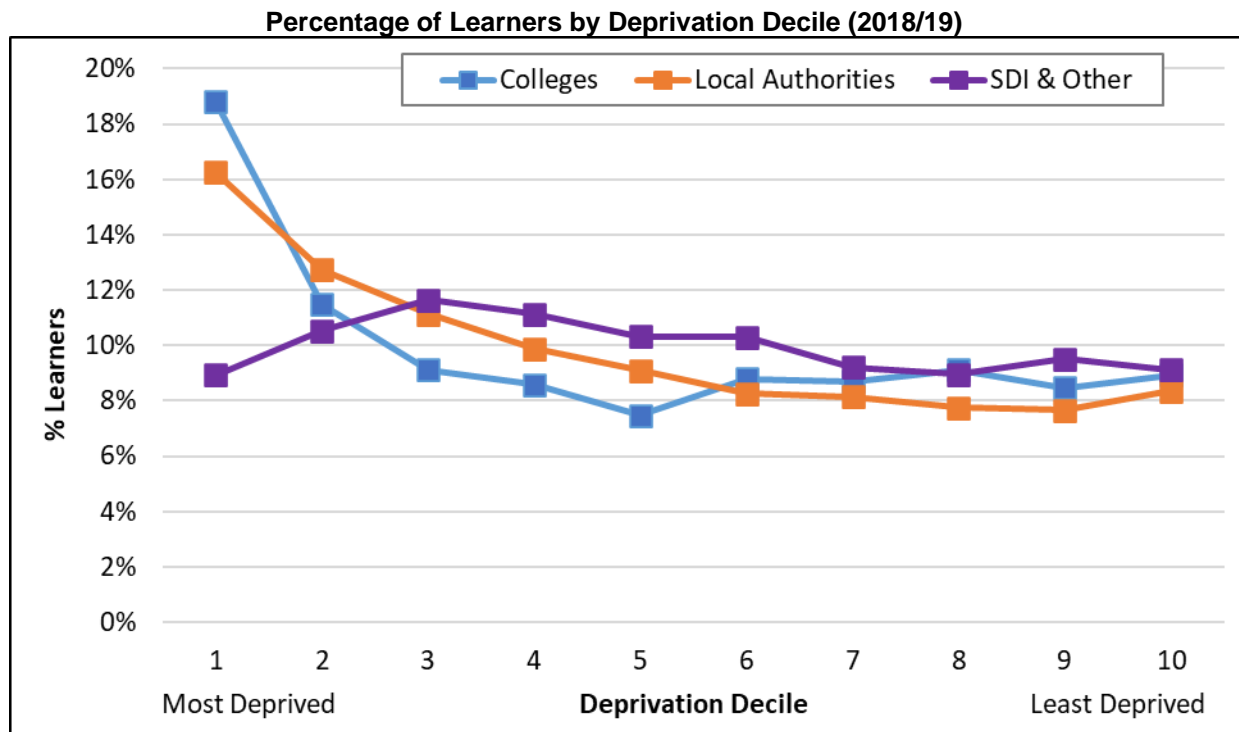

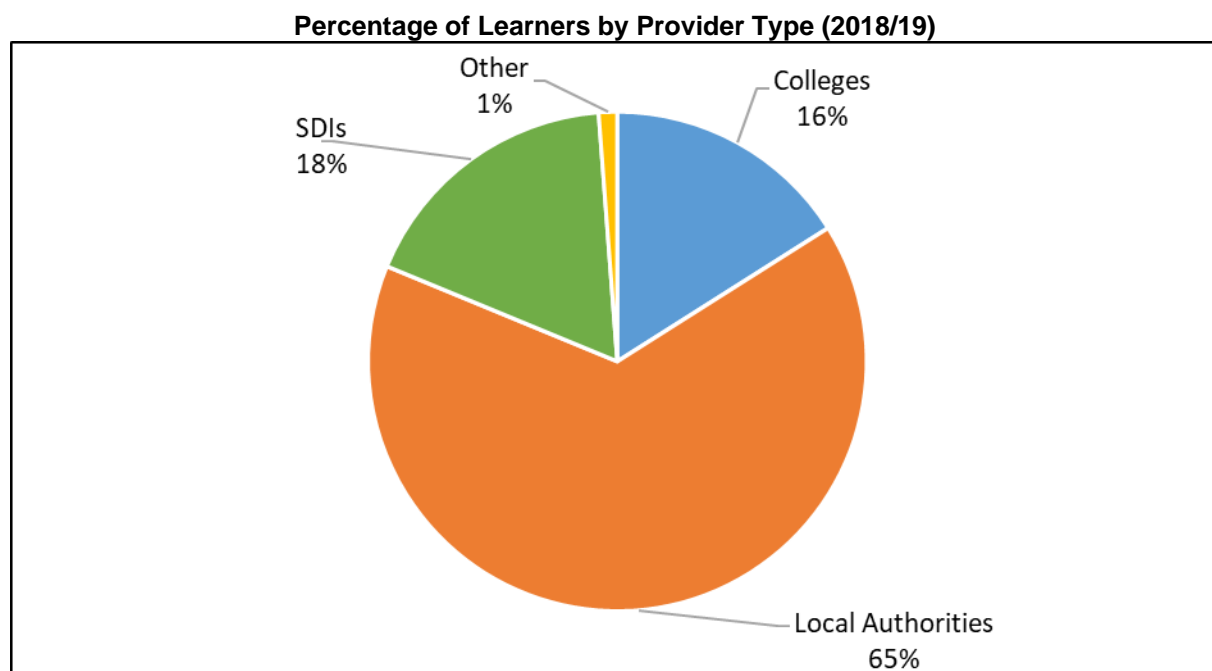

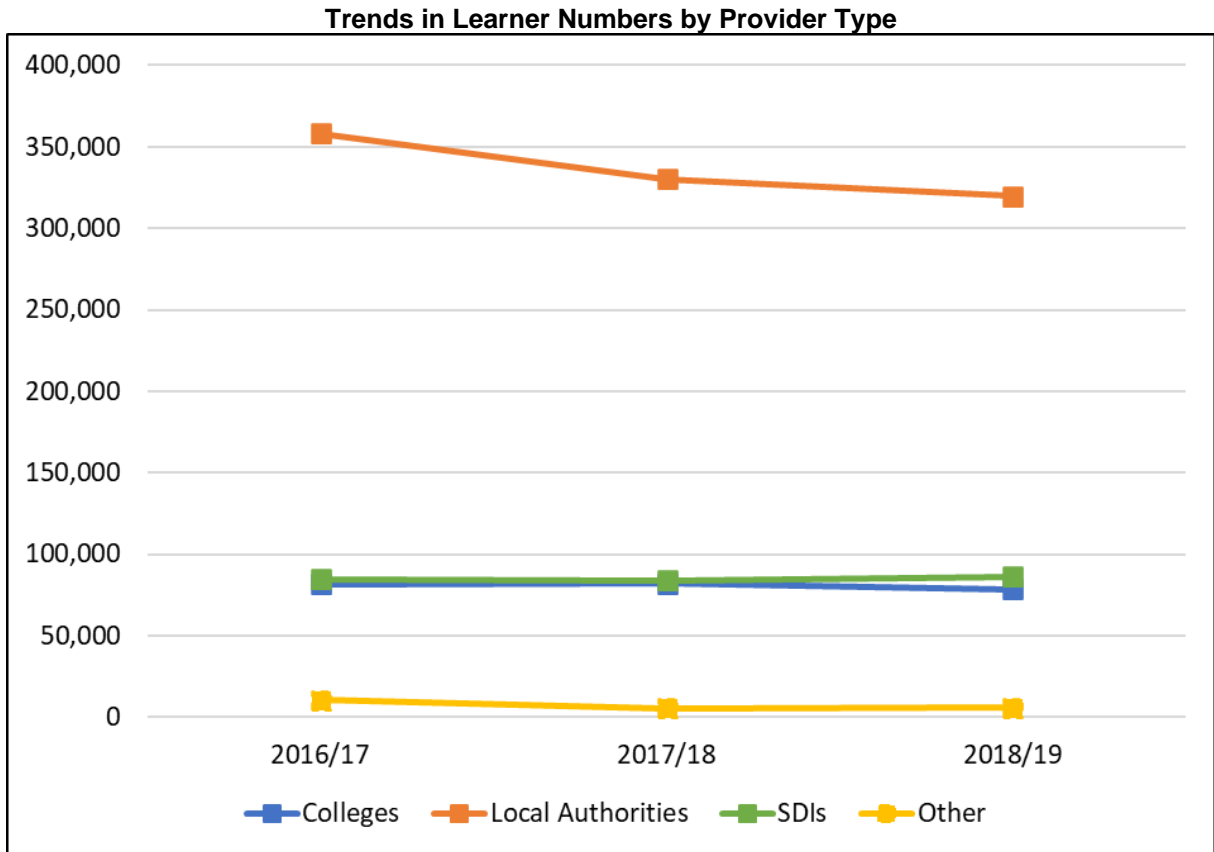

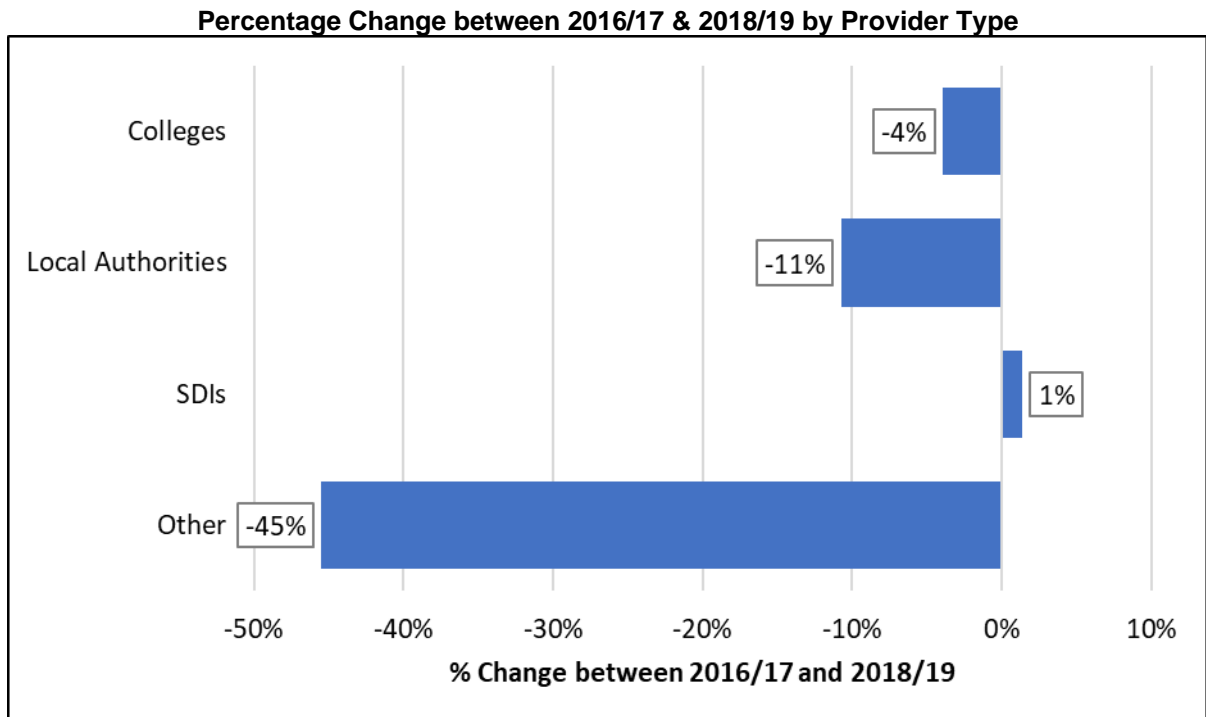

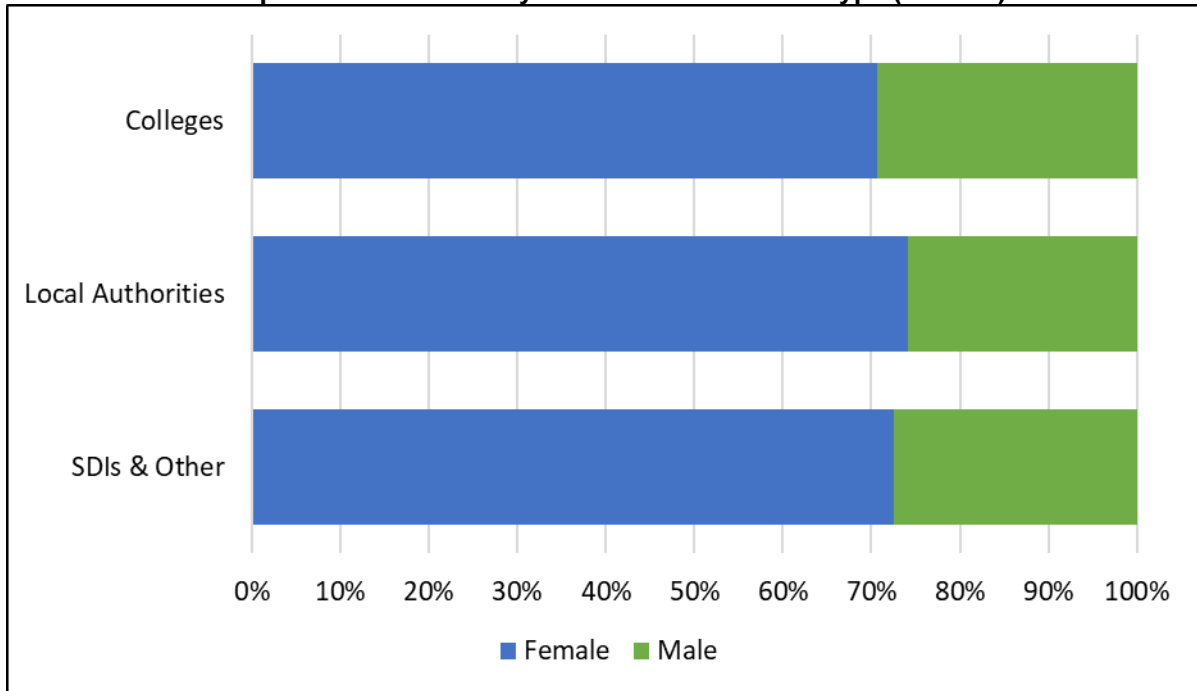

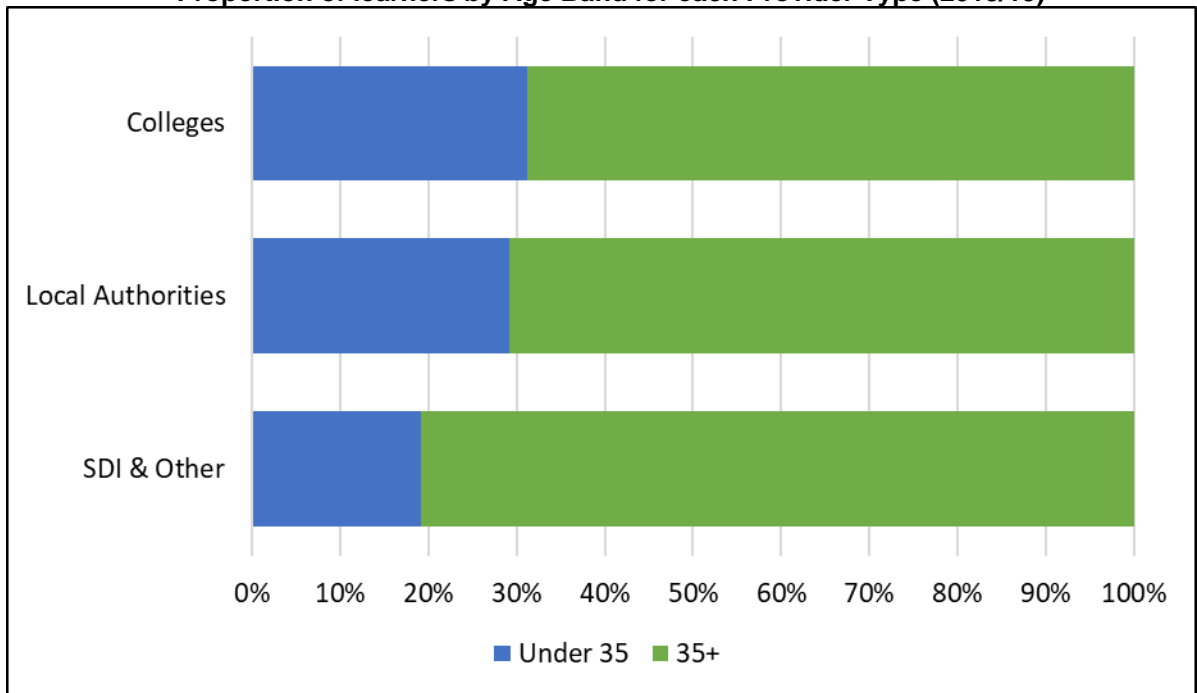

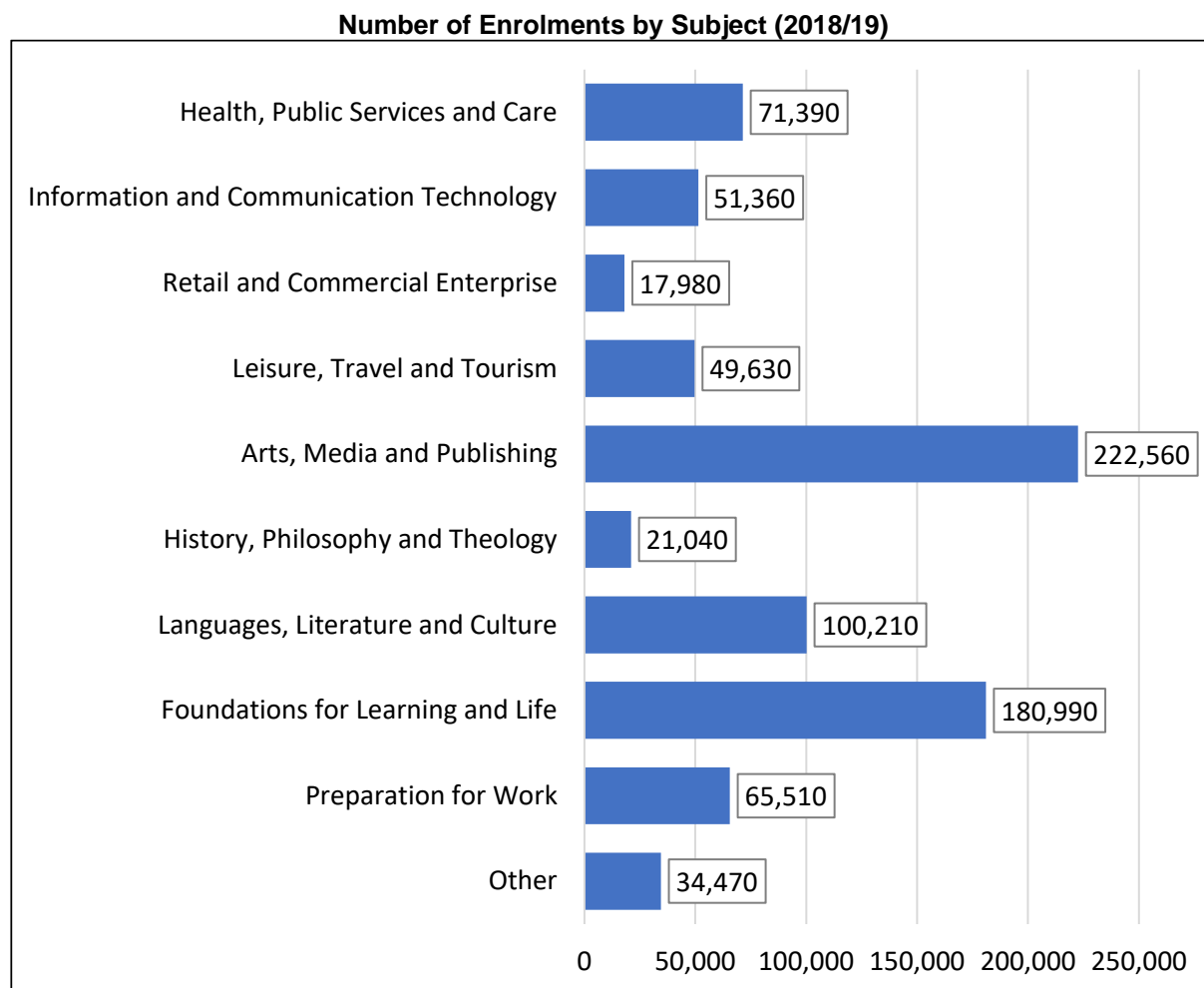
Proportion of learners by Age Band for each Provider Type (2018/19)

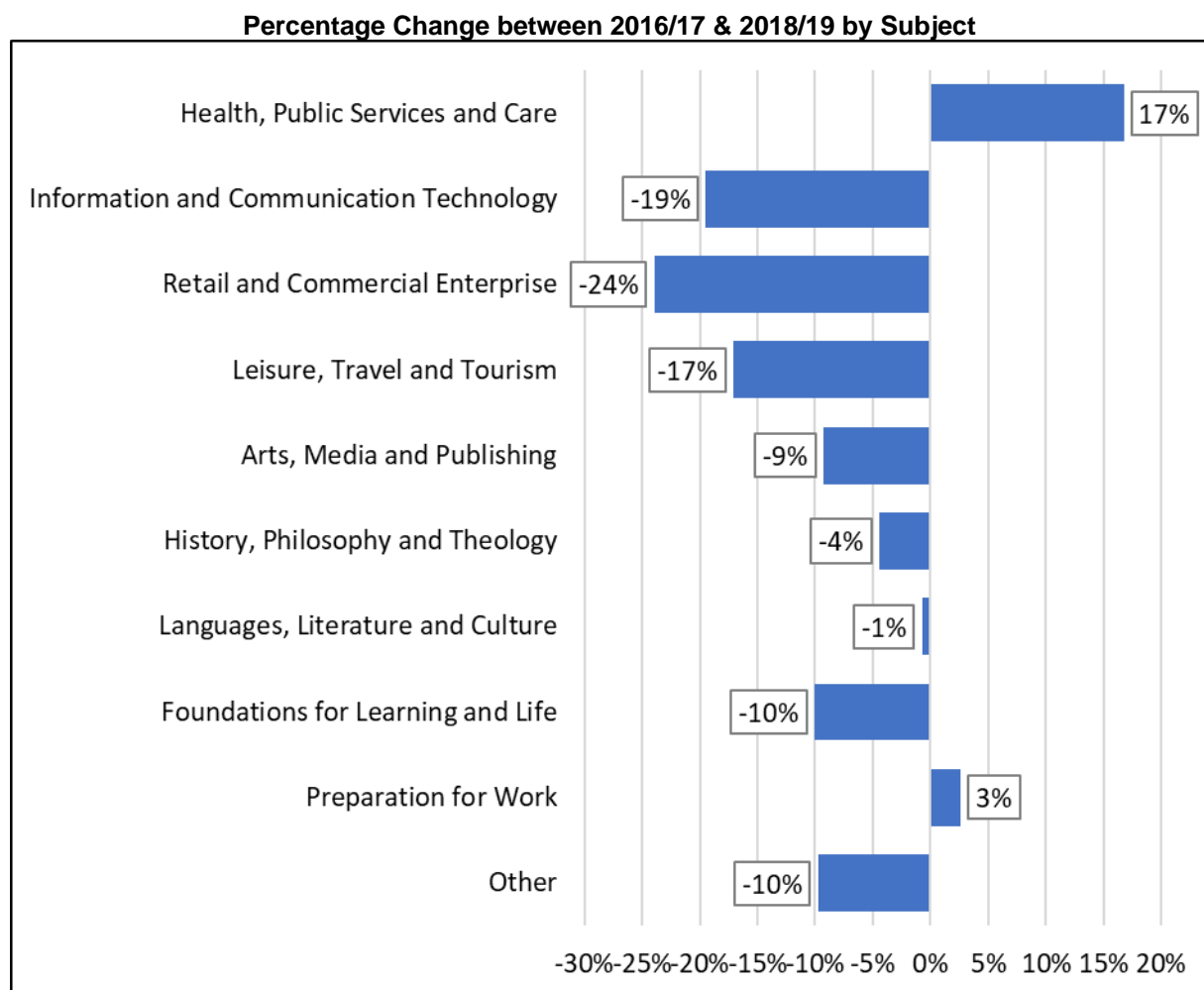

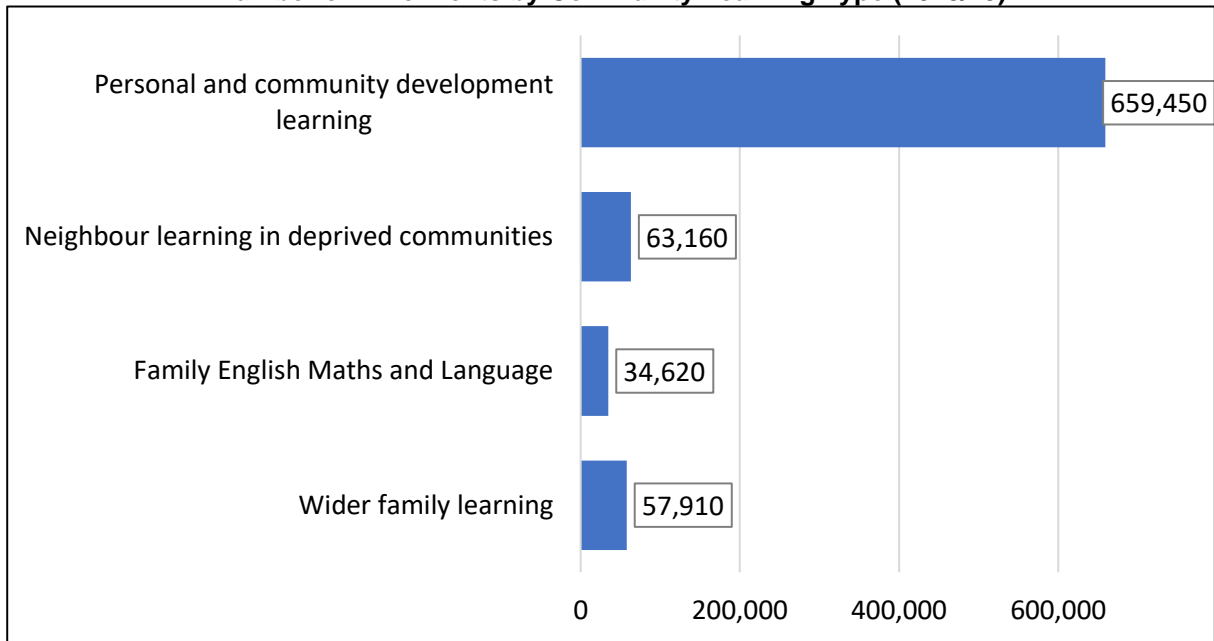

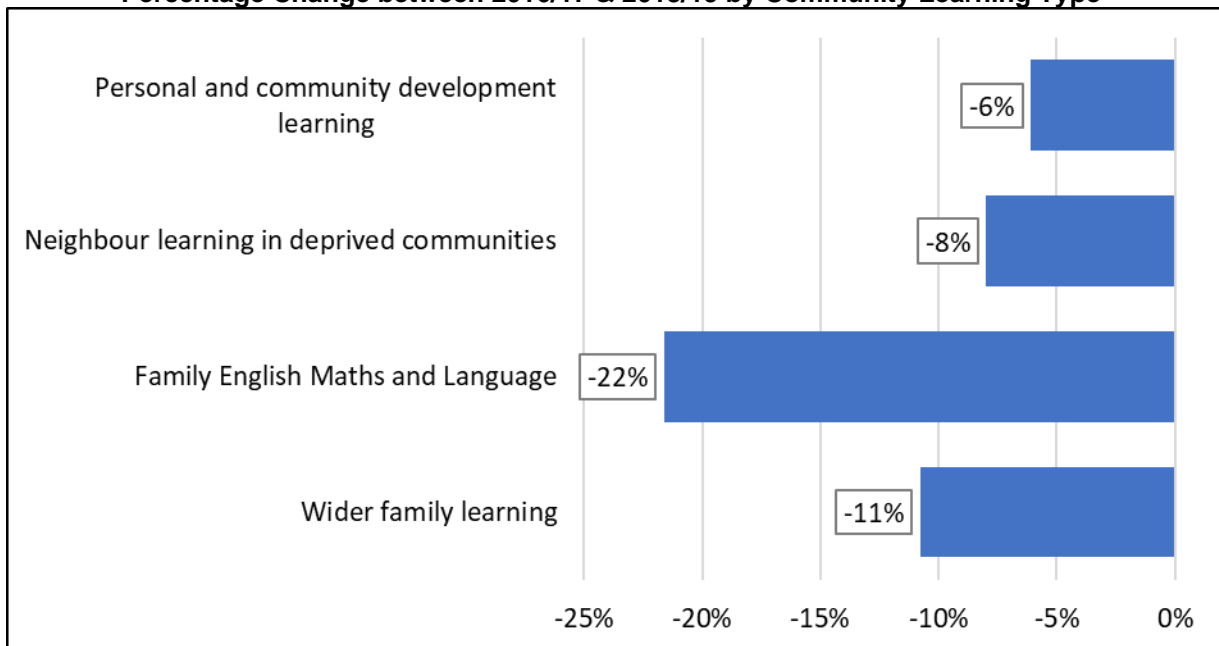
2.8 Community Learning Type

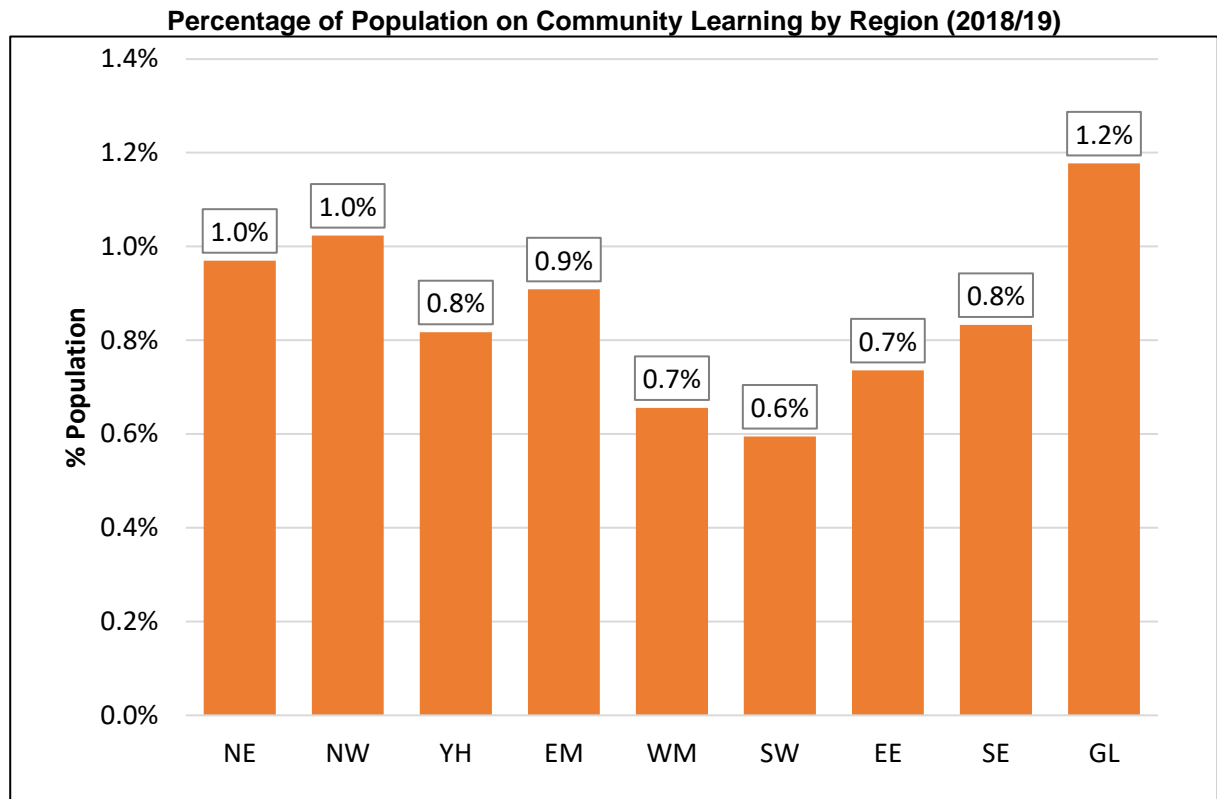
Percentage Change between 2016/17 & 2018/19 by Community Learning Type



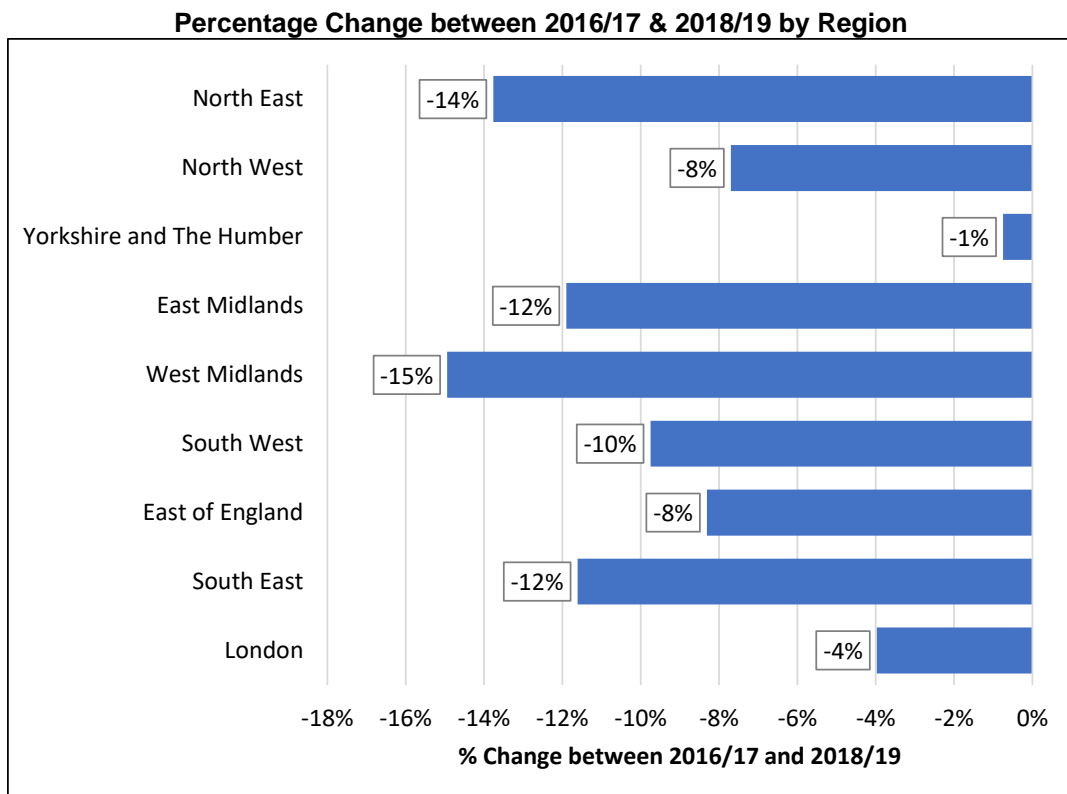

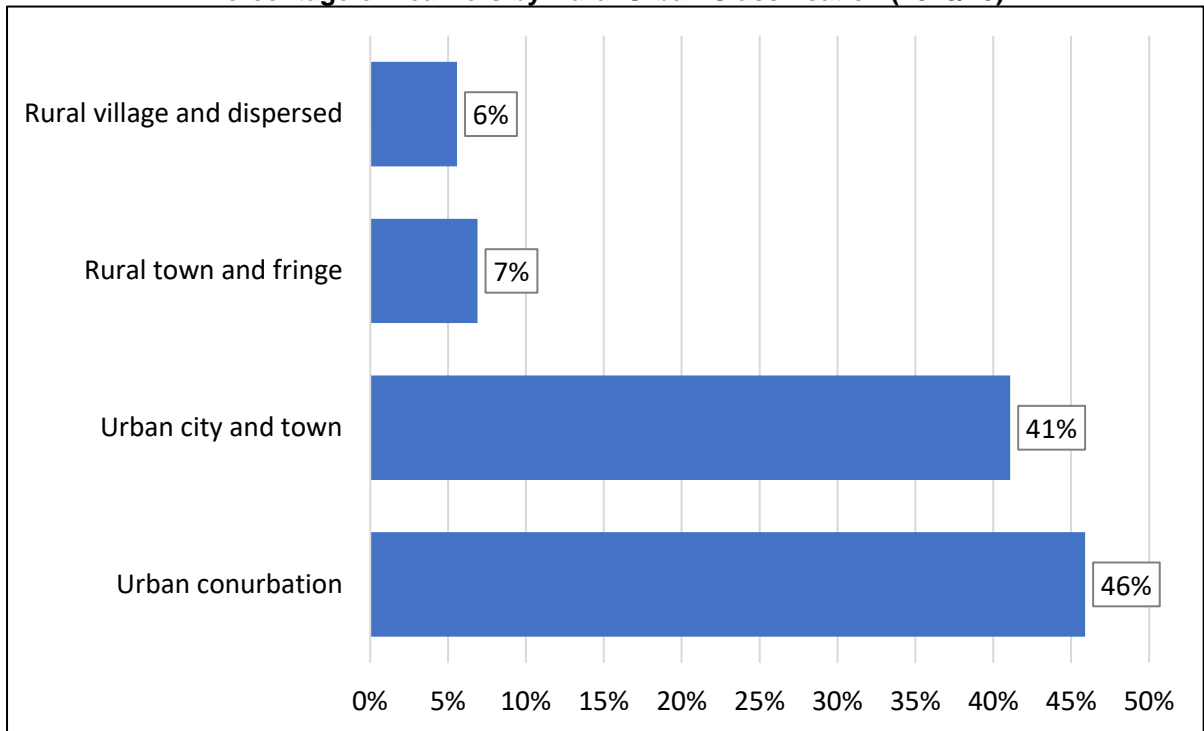

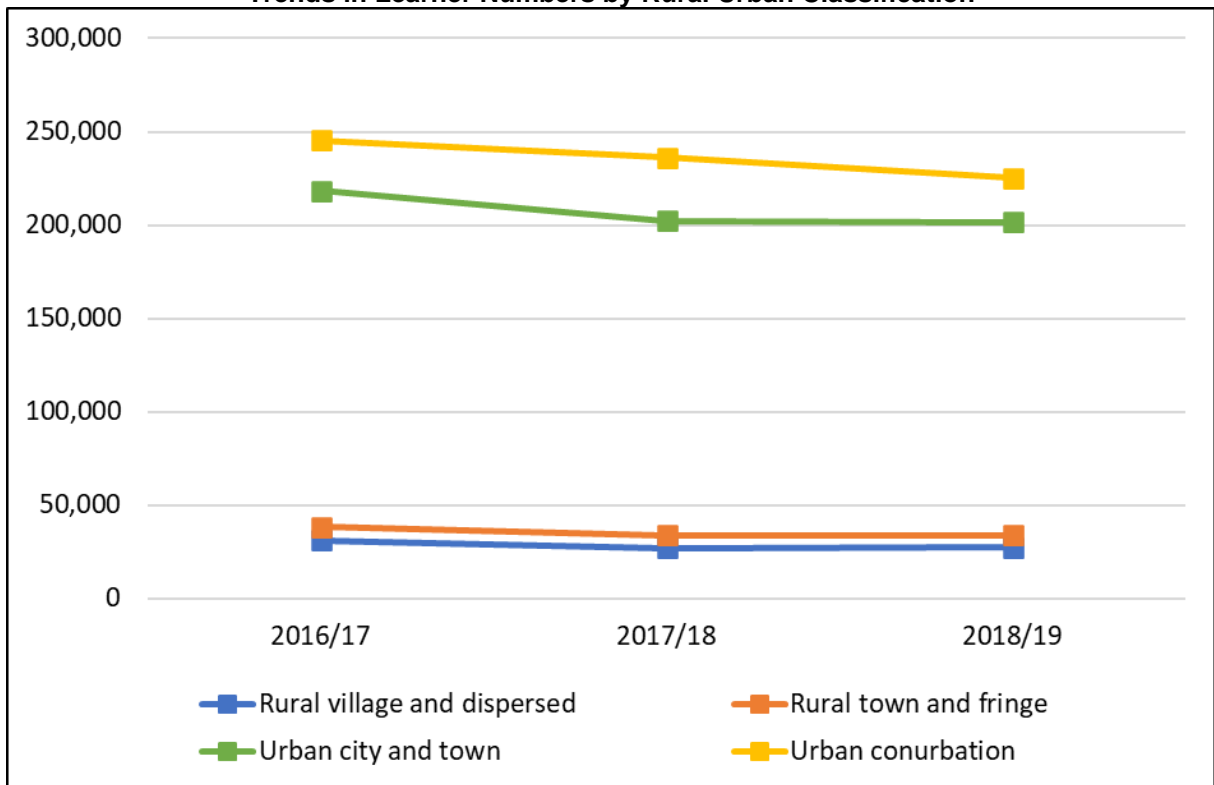
2.10 Rural Urban Classification

Percentage of Learners by Rural Urban Classification (2018/19)



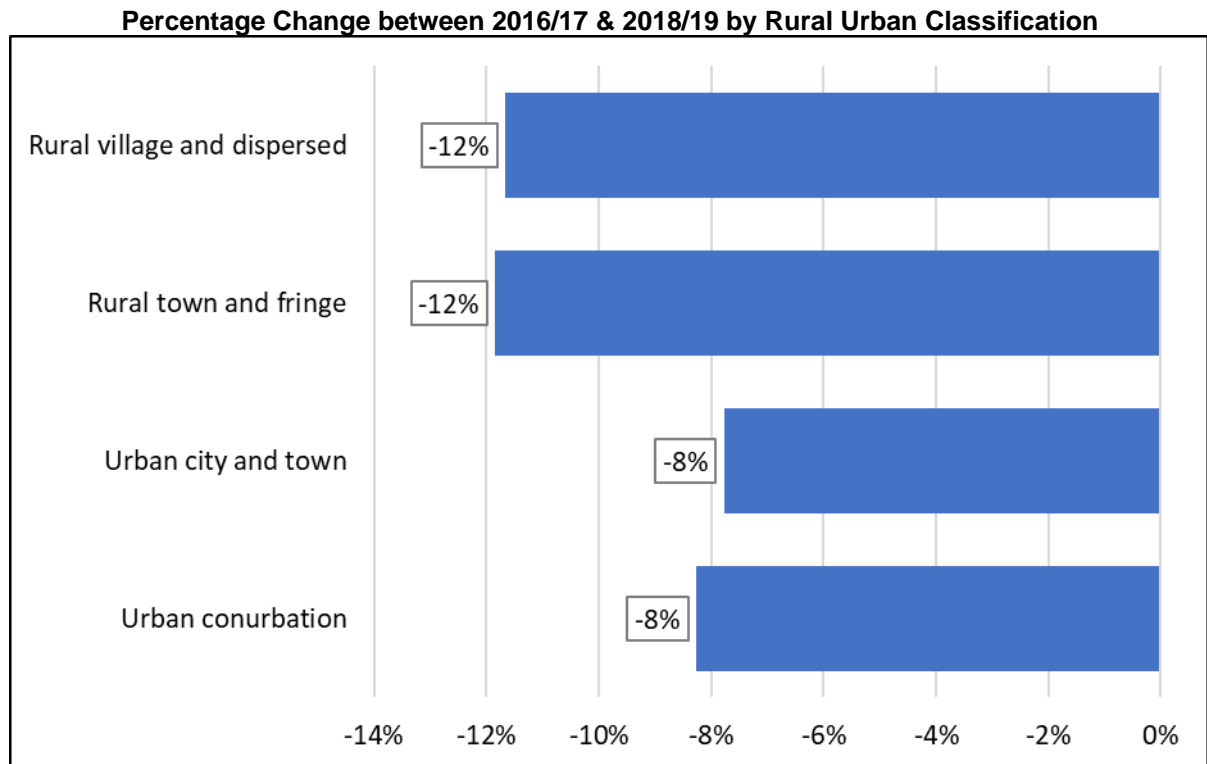

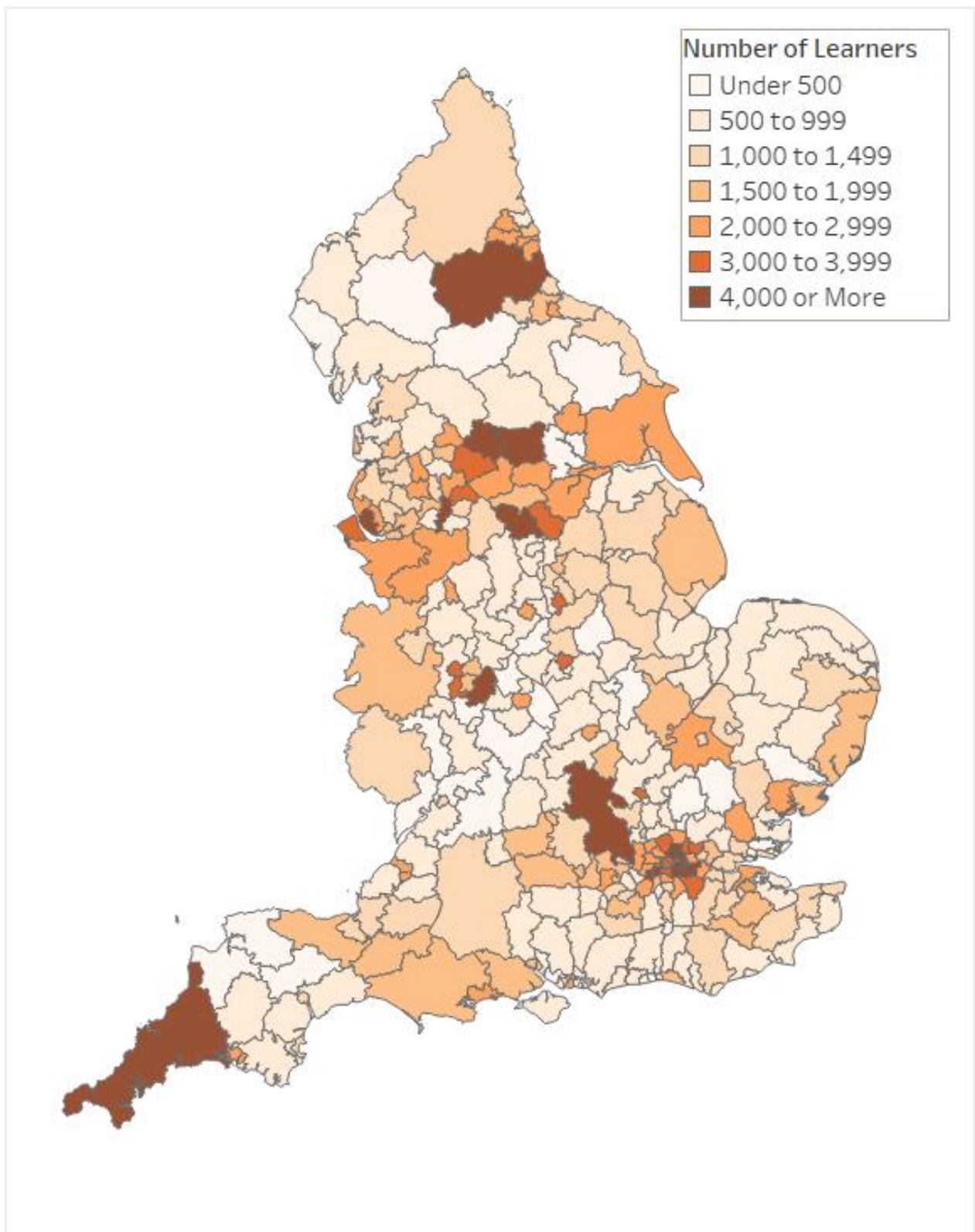

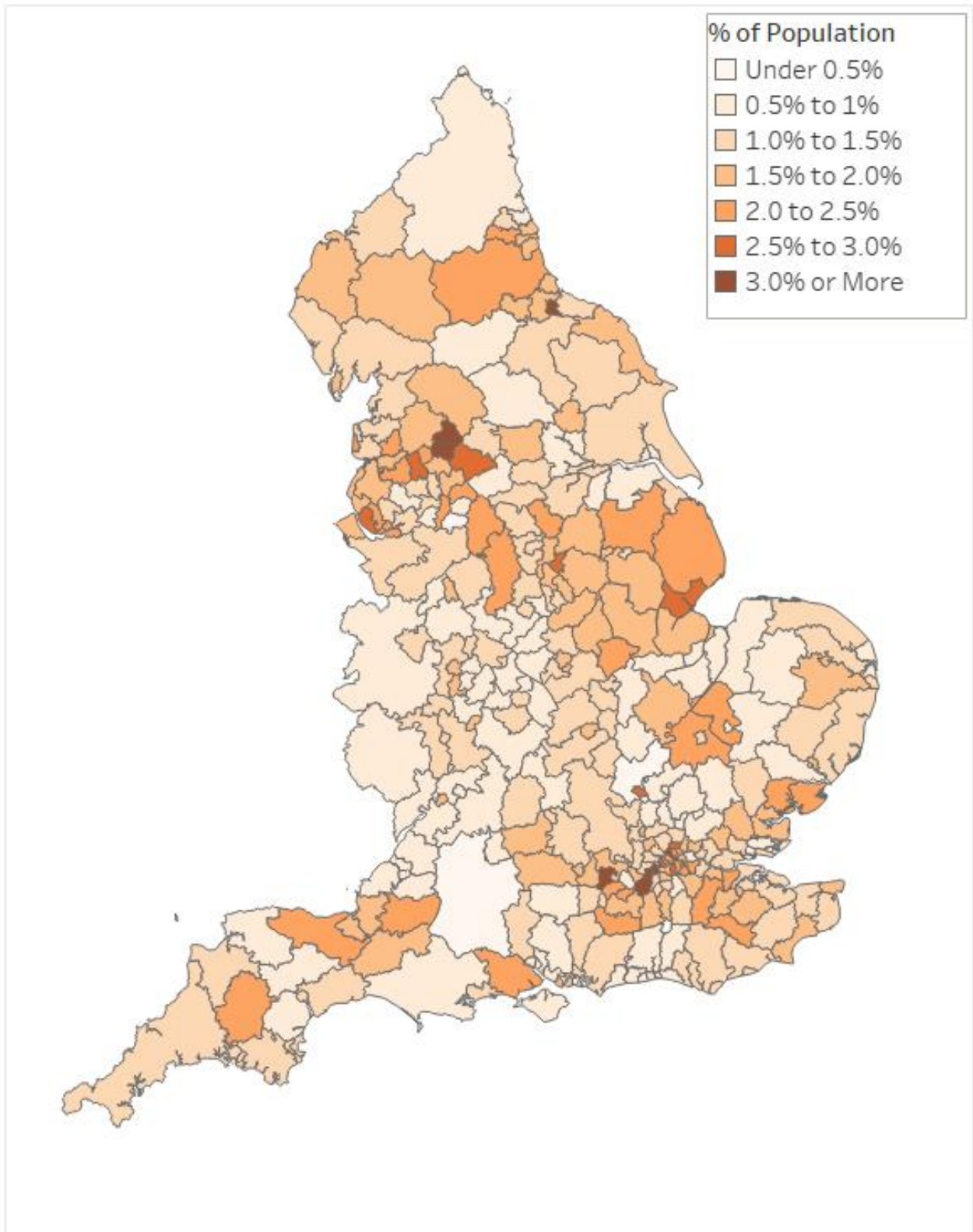
Number of Learners by Local Authority District (2018/19)

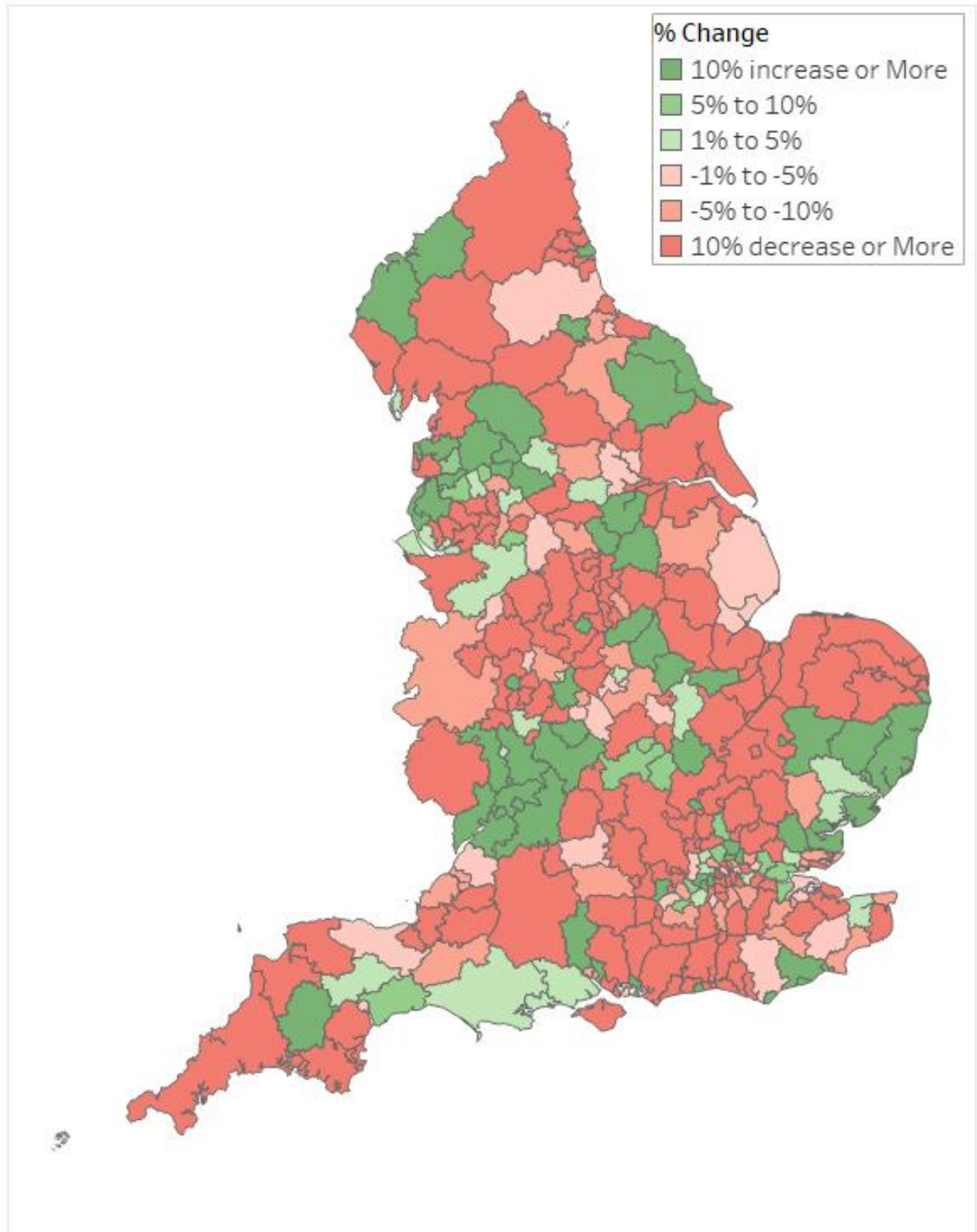
Number of Learners as a percentage of 18-64 Population by Local Authority District (2018/19)

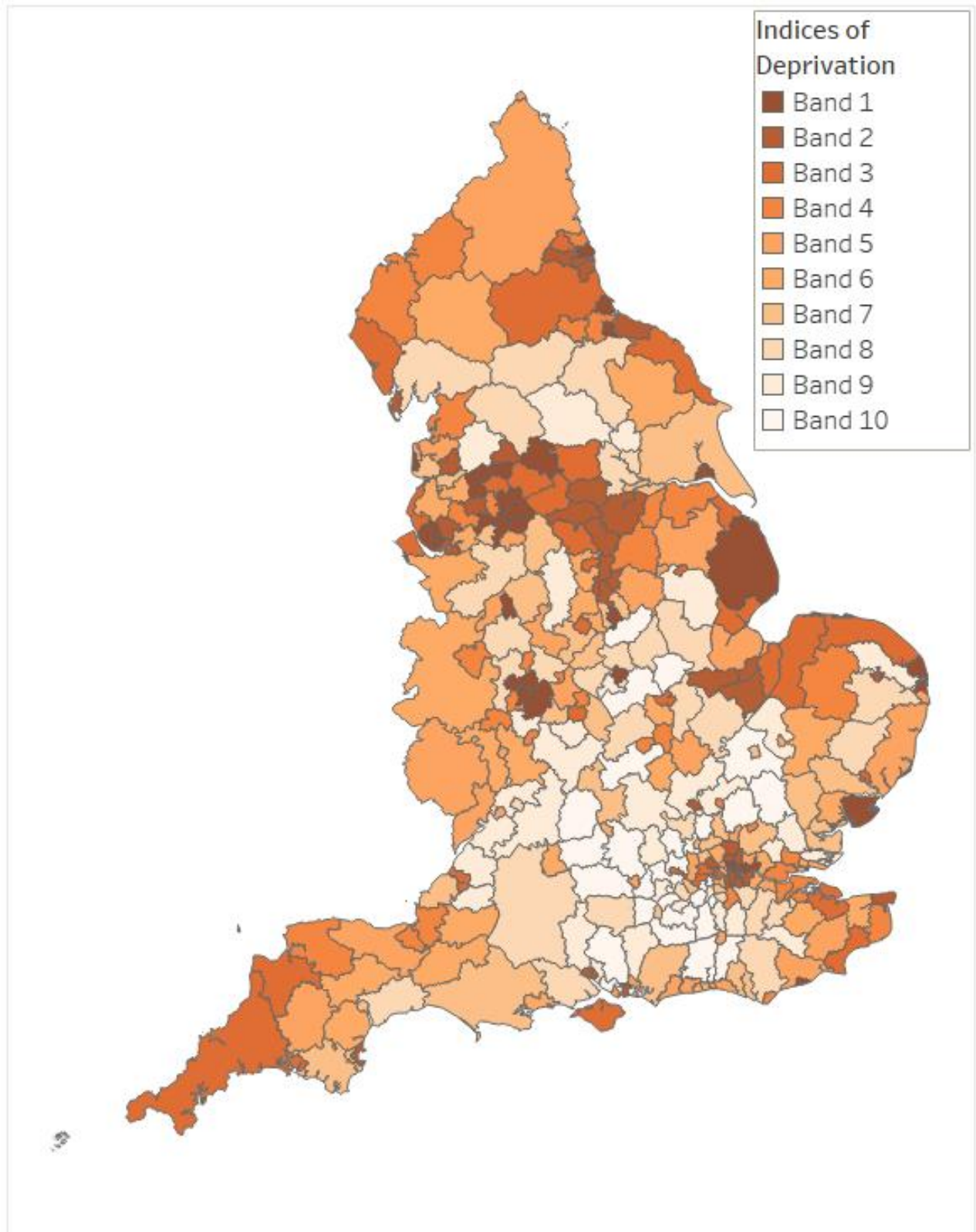
Percentage Change between 2016/17 and 2018/19

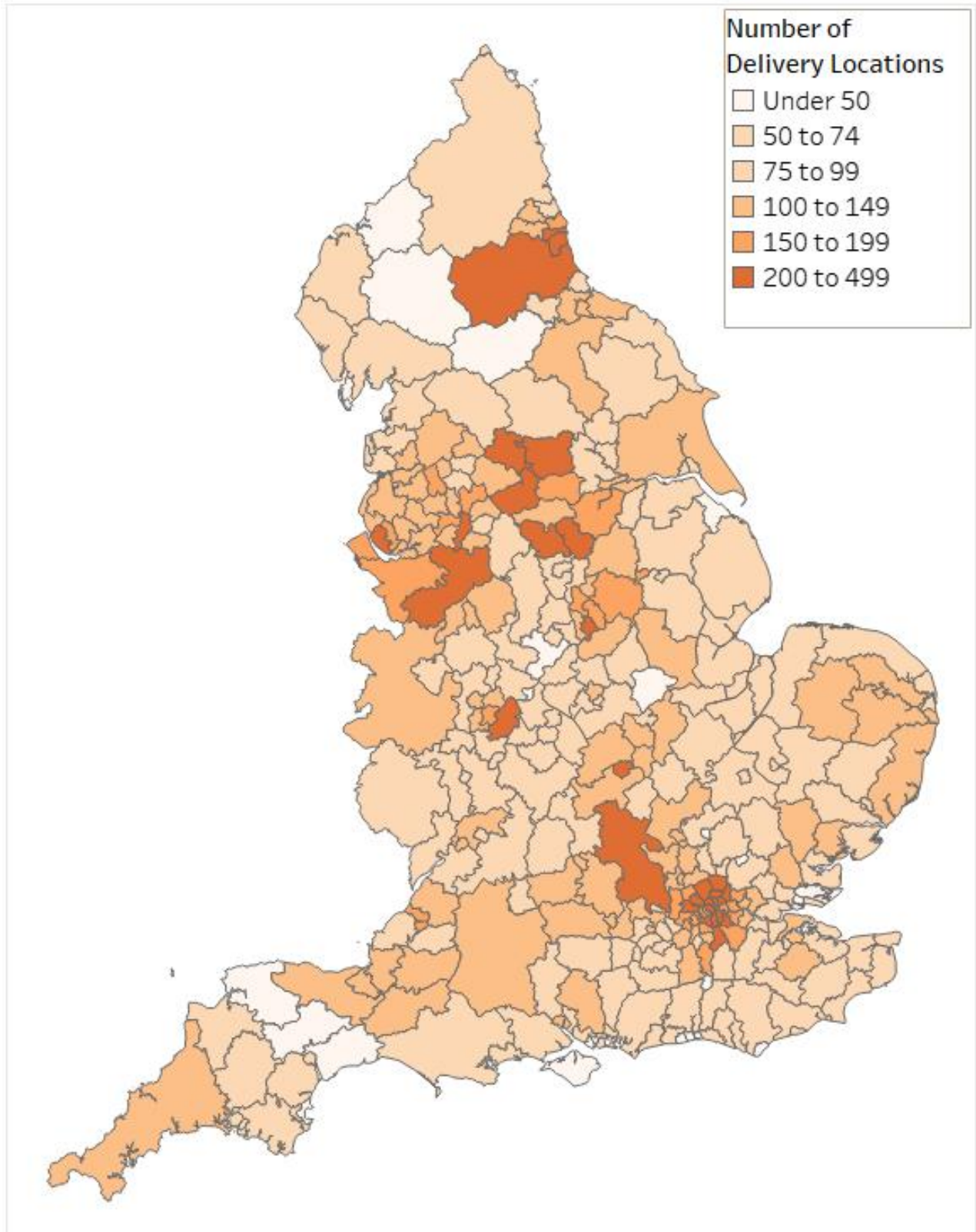
Indices of Deprivation

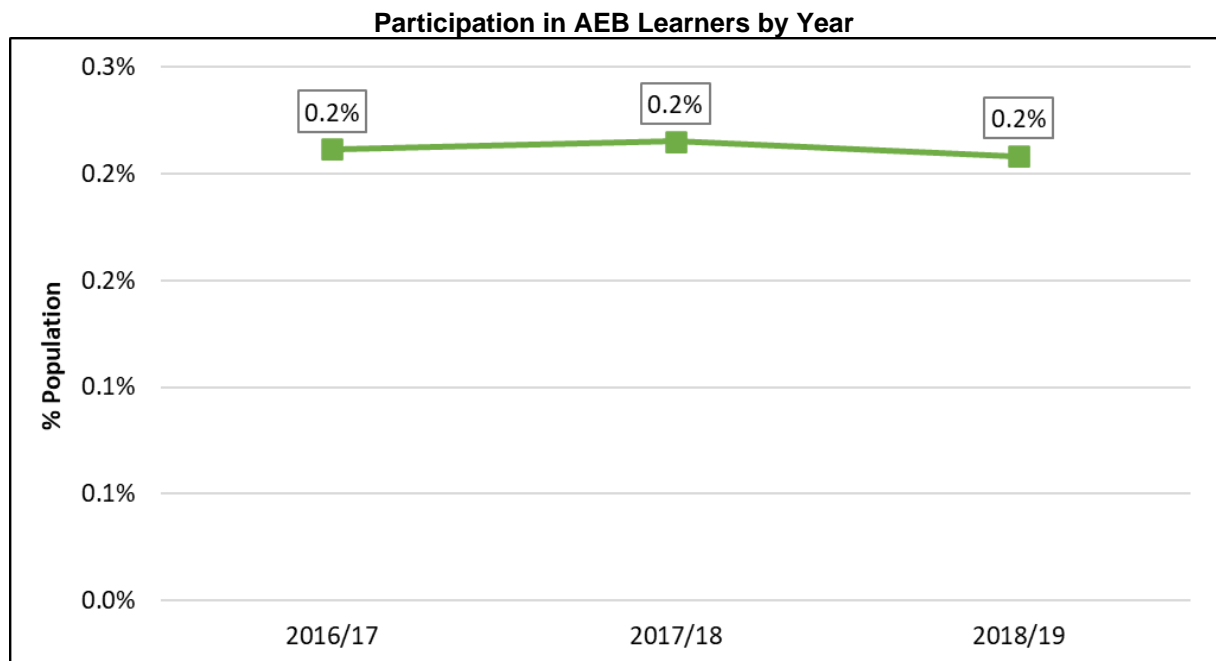

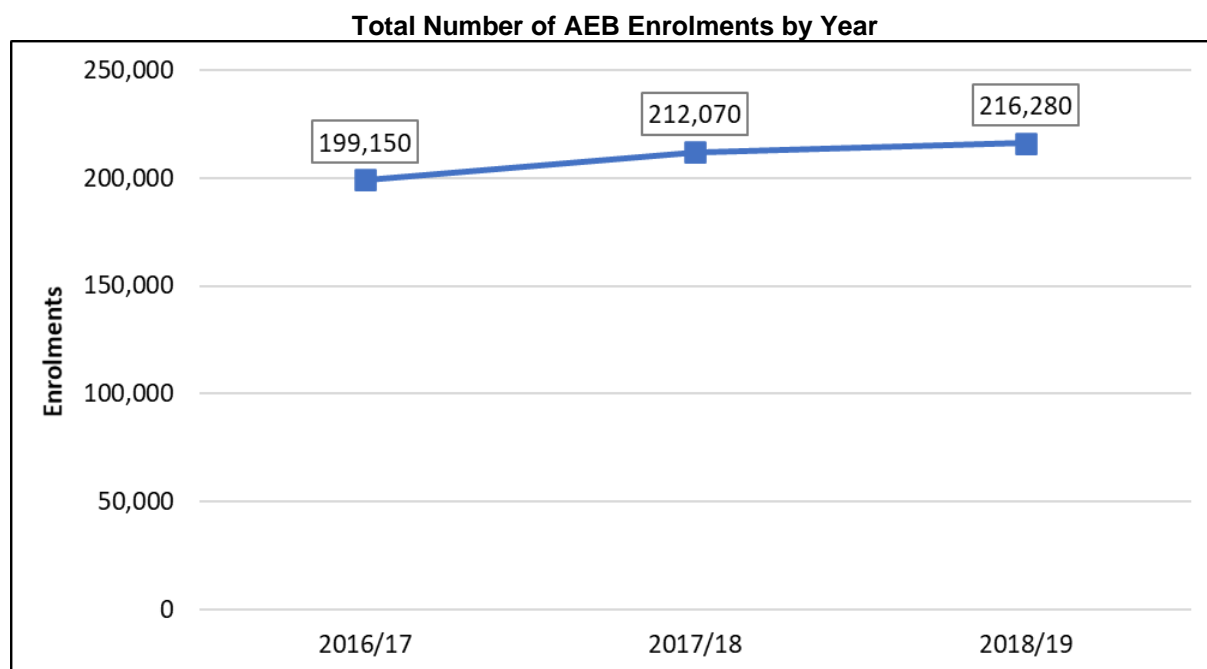

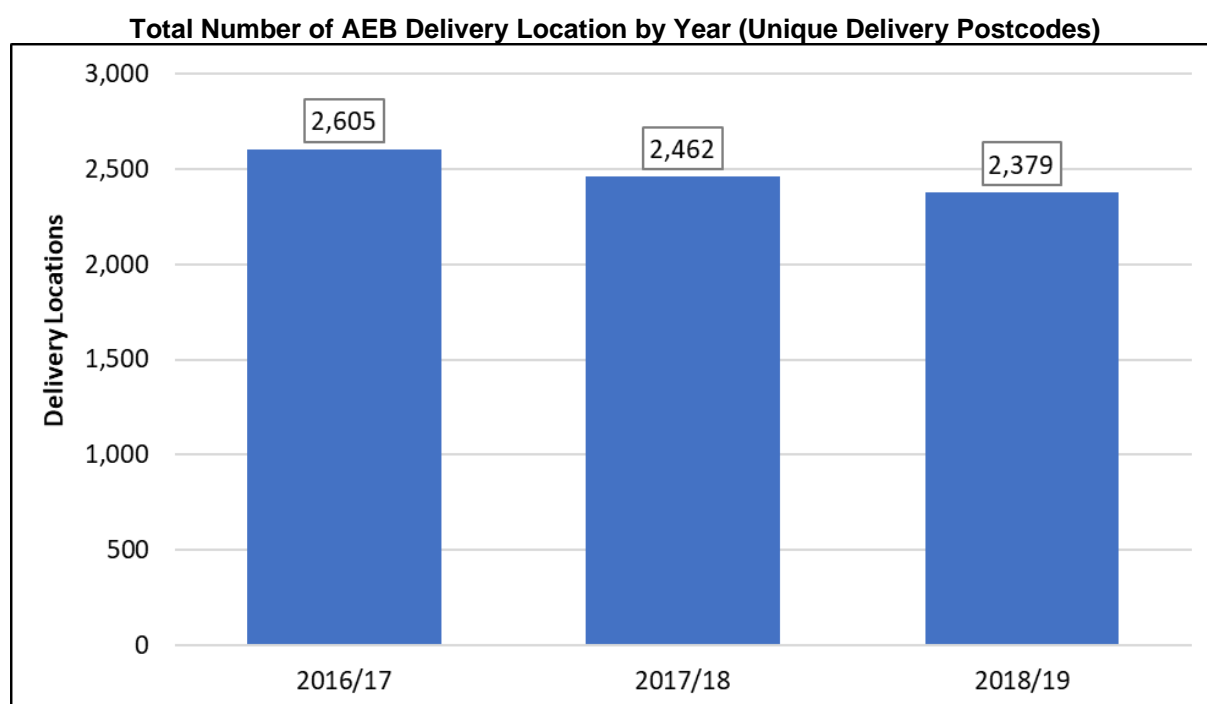

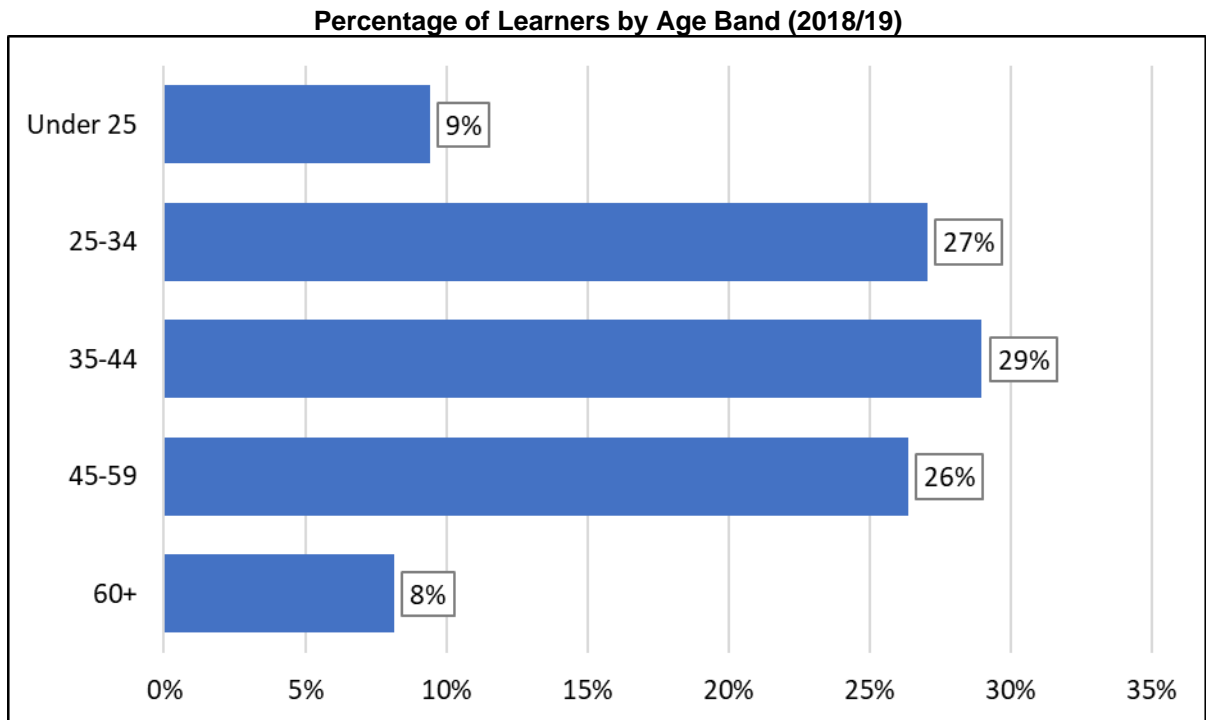

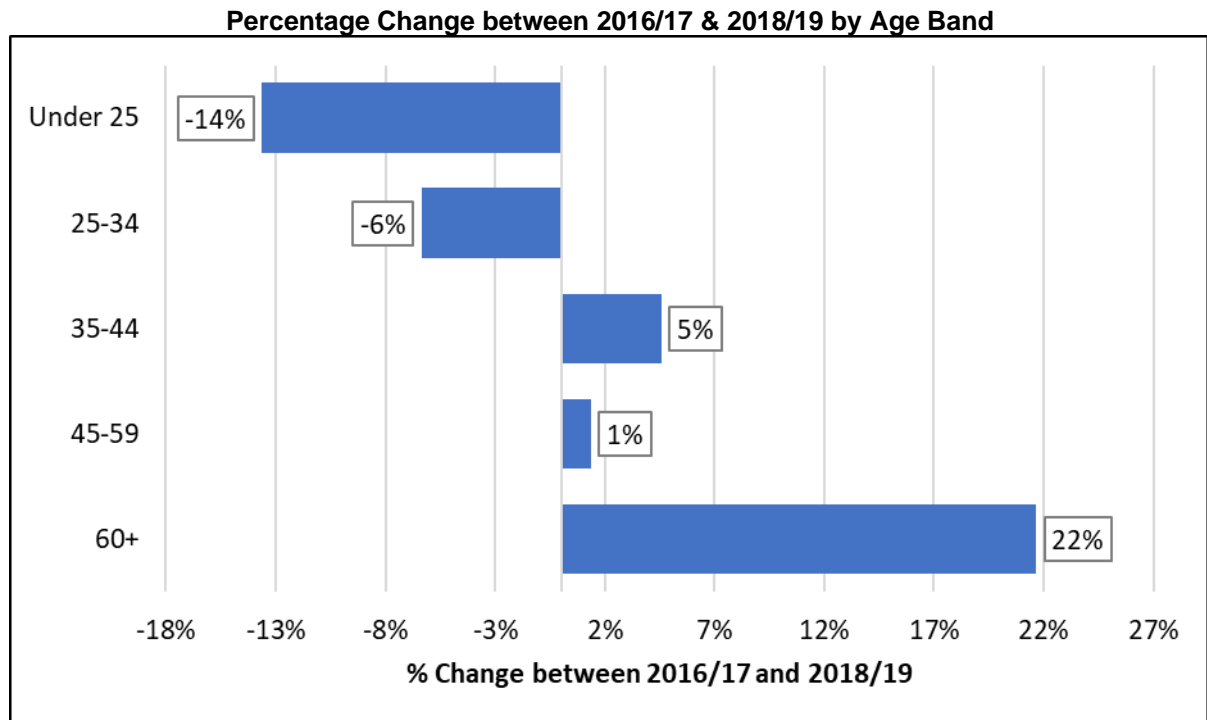

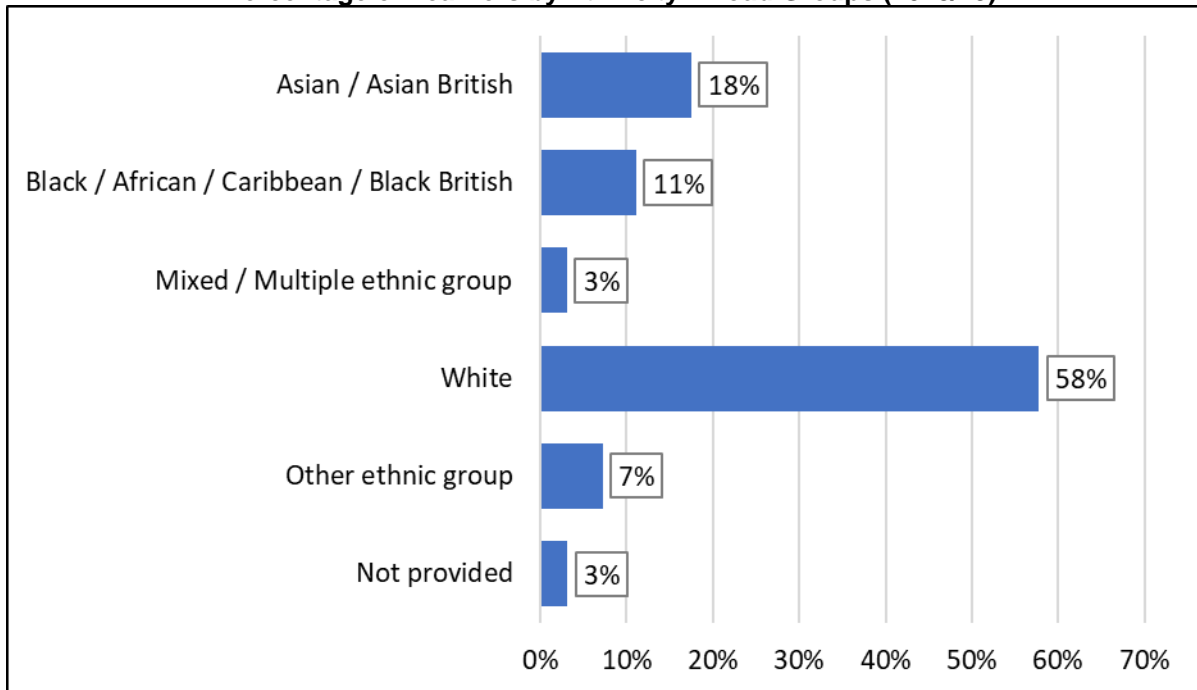

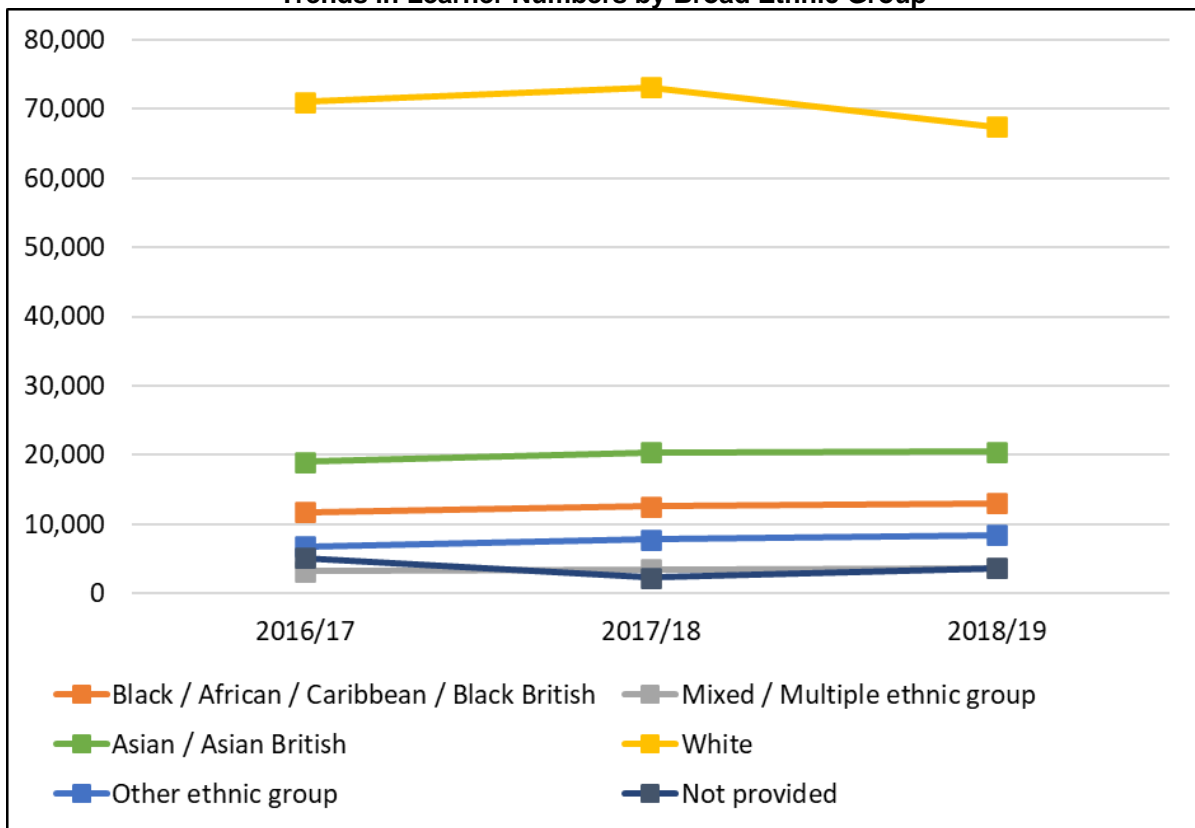

Percentage of Learners by Ethnicity- Broad Groups (2018/19)



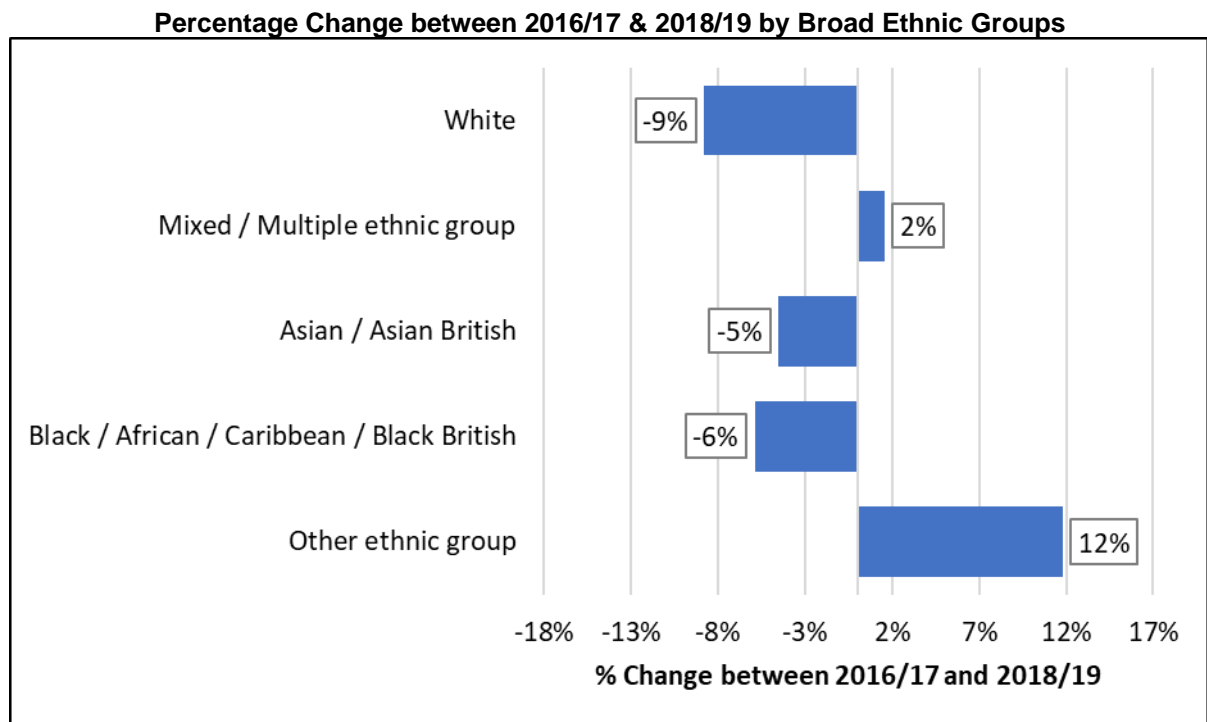

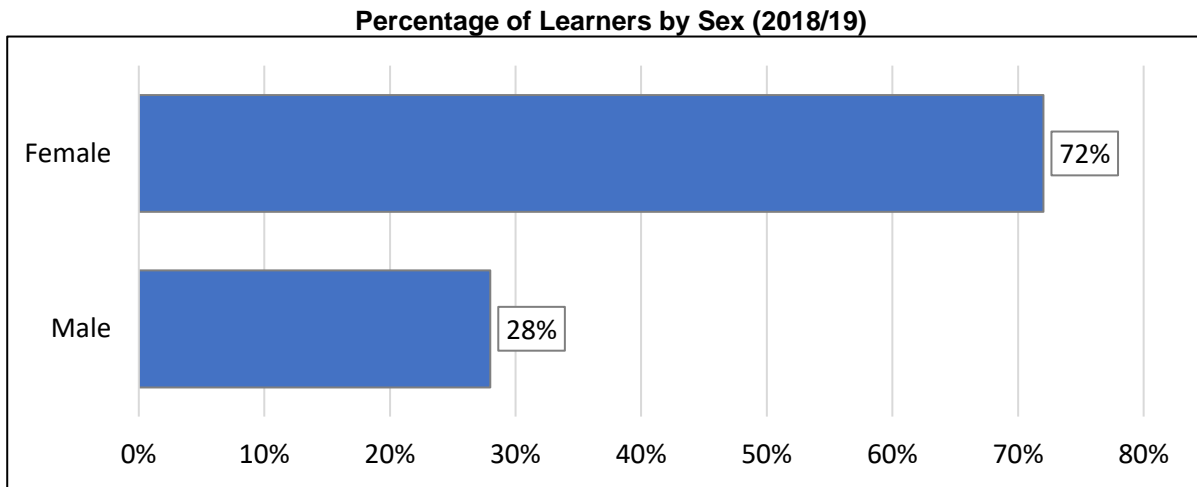

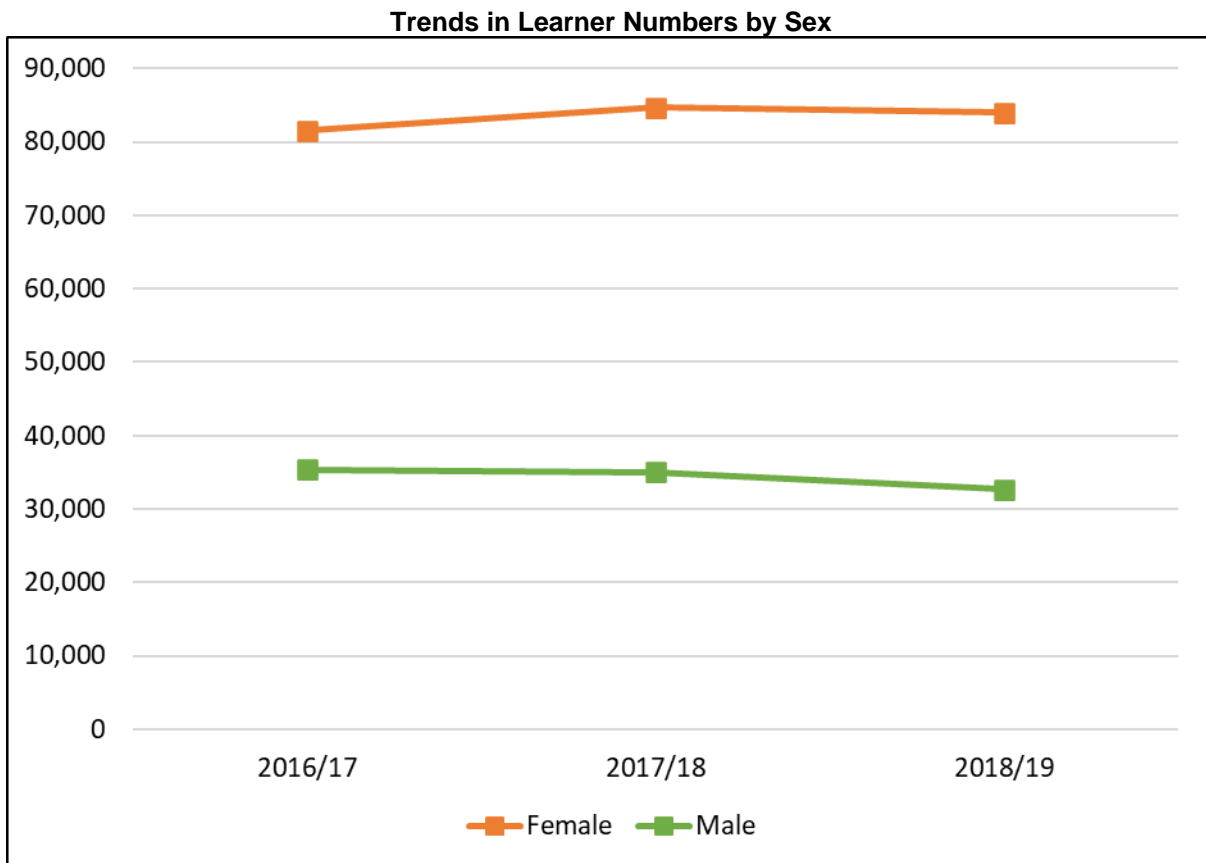

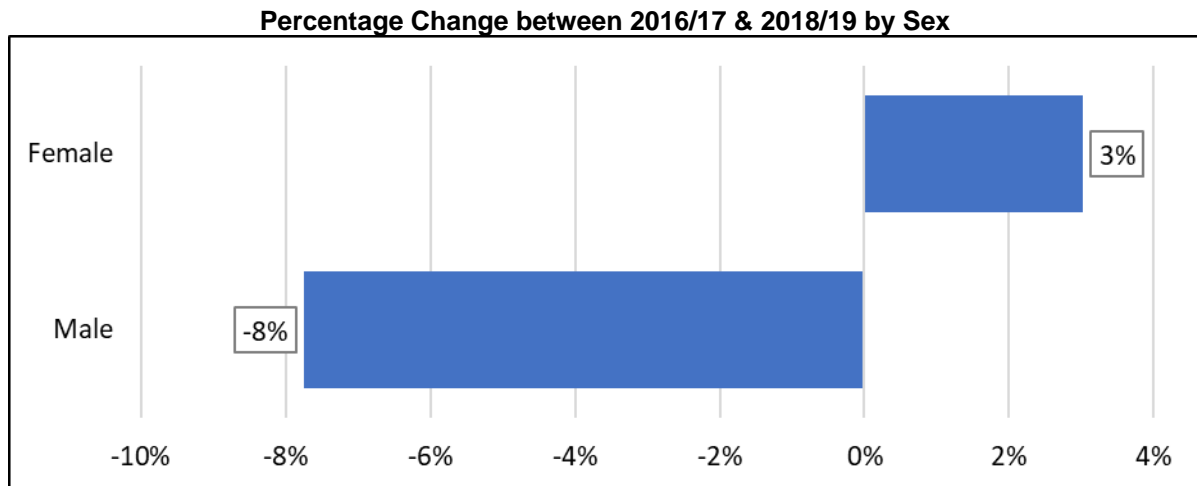

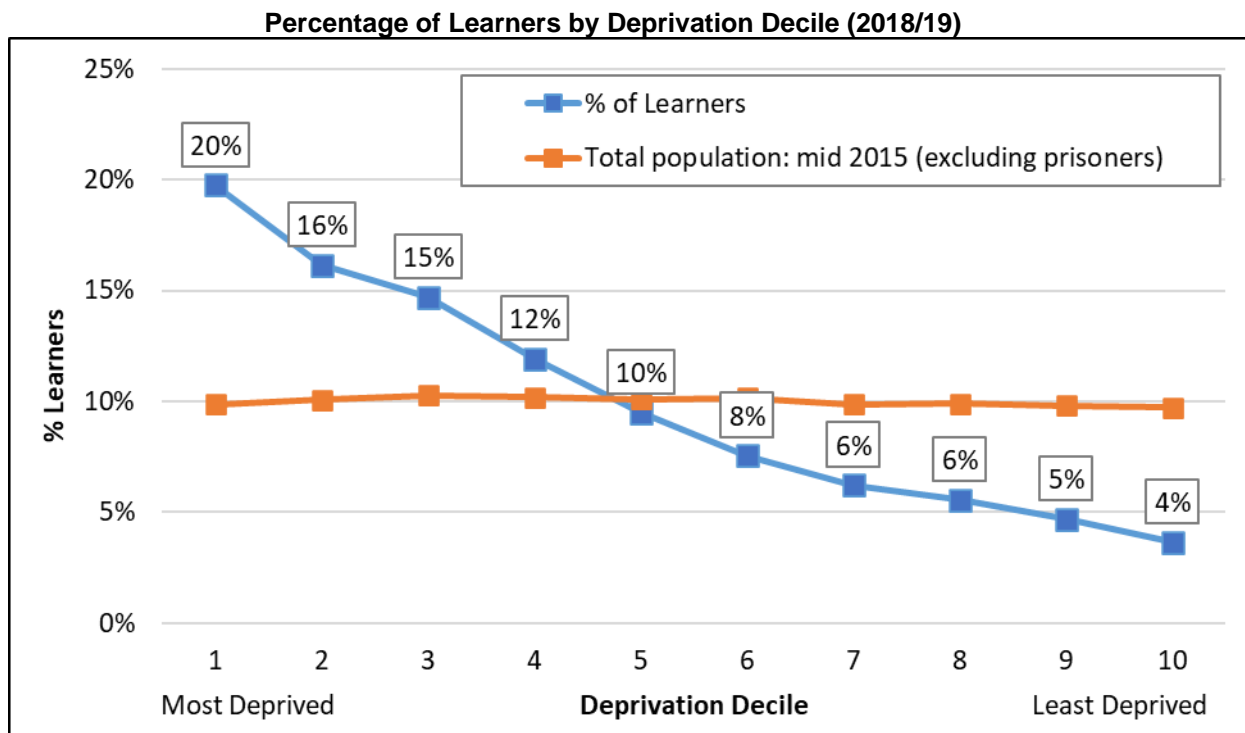

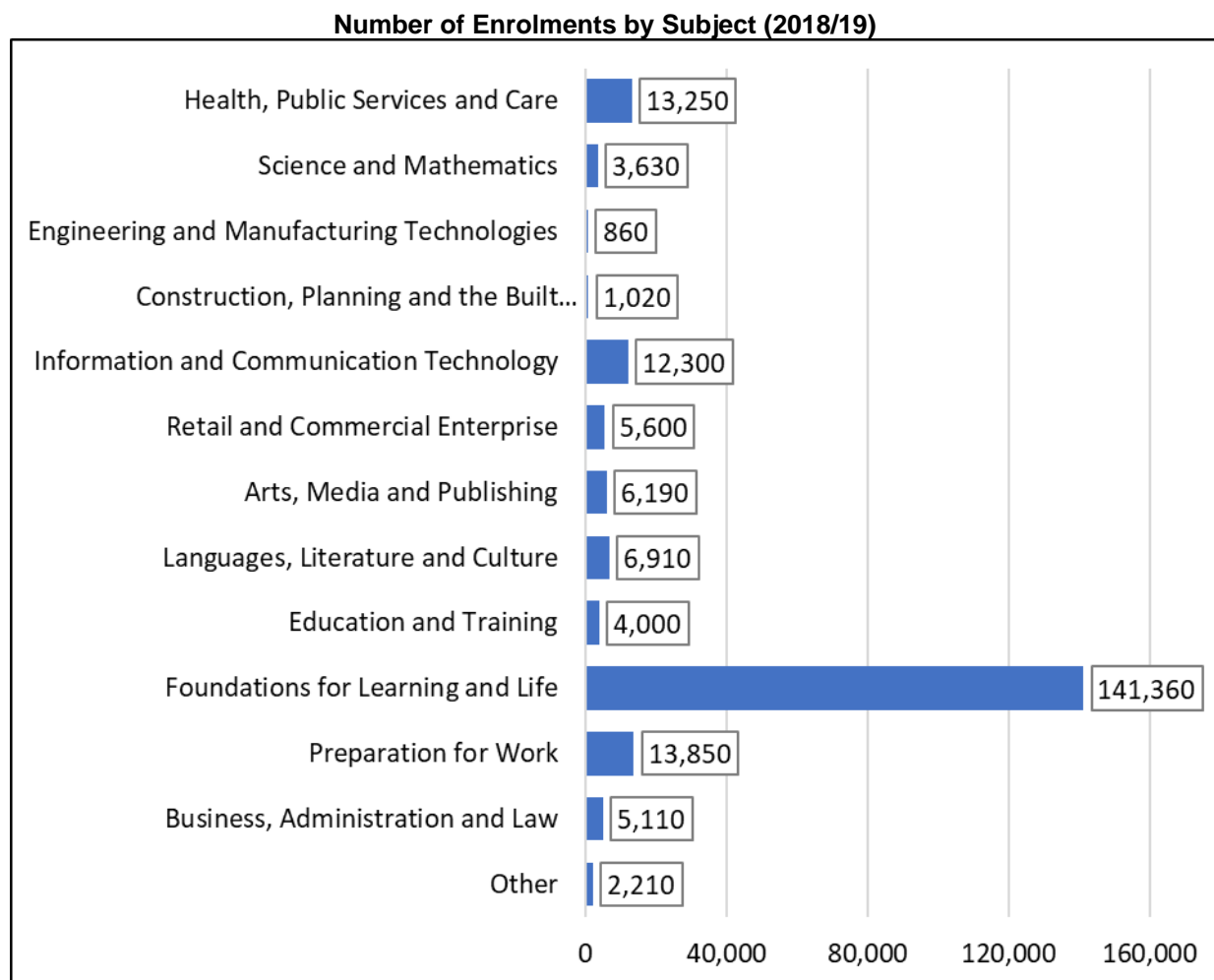
3.5 Deprivation

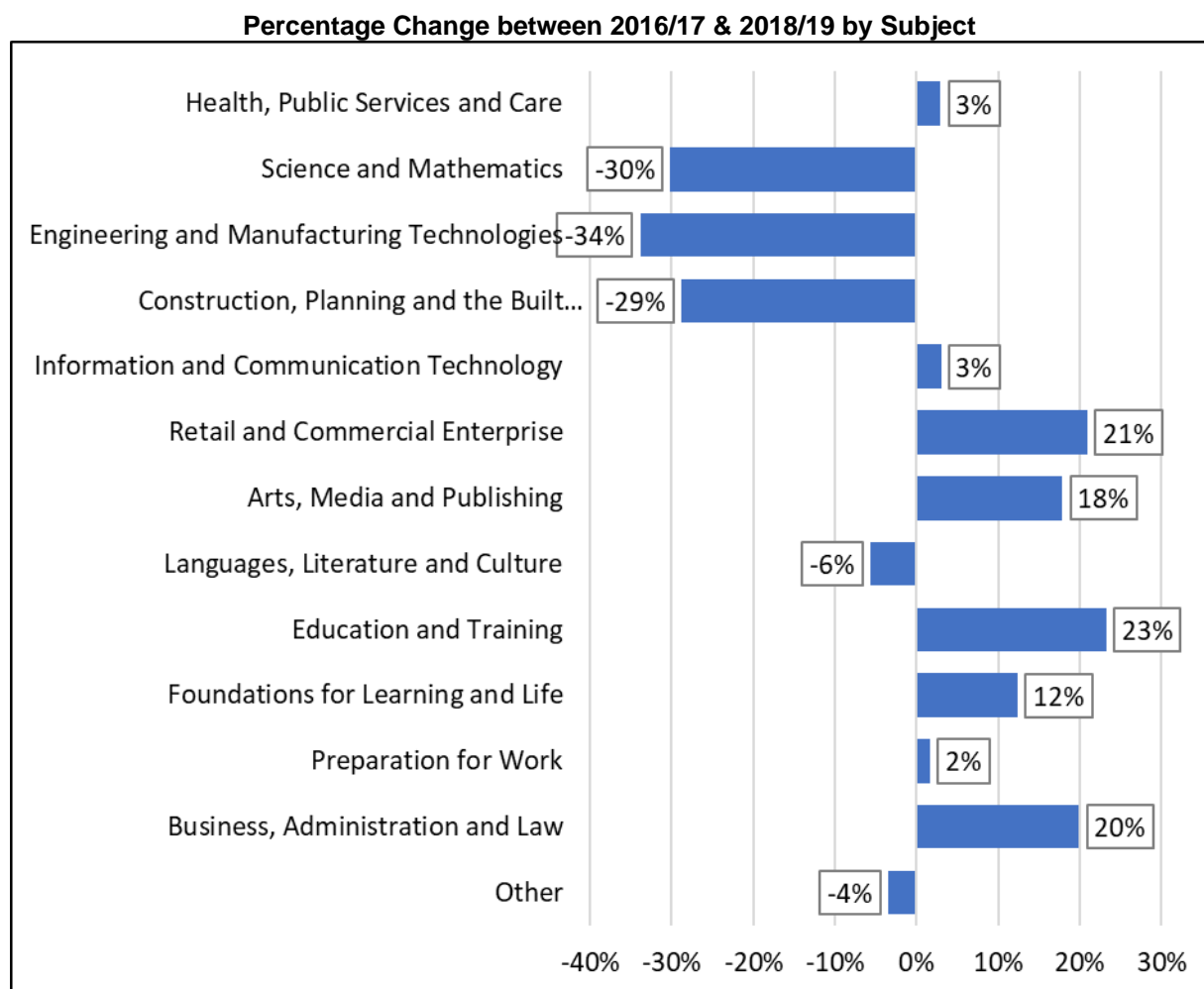

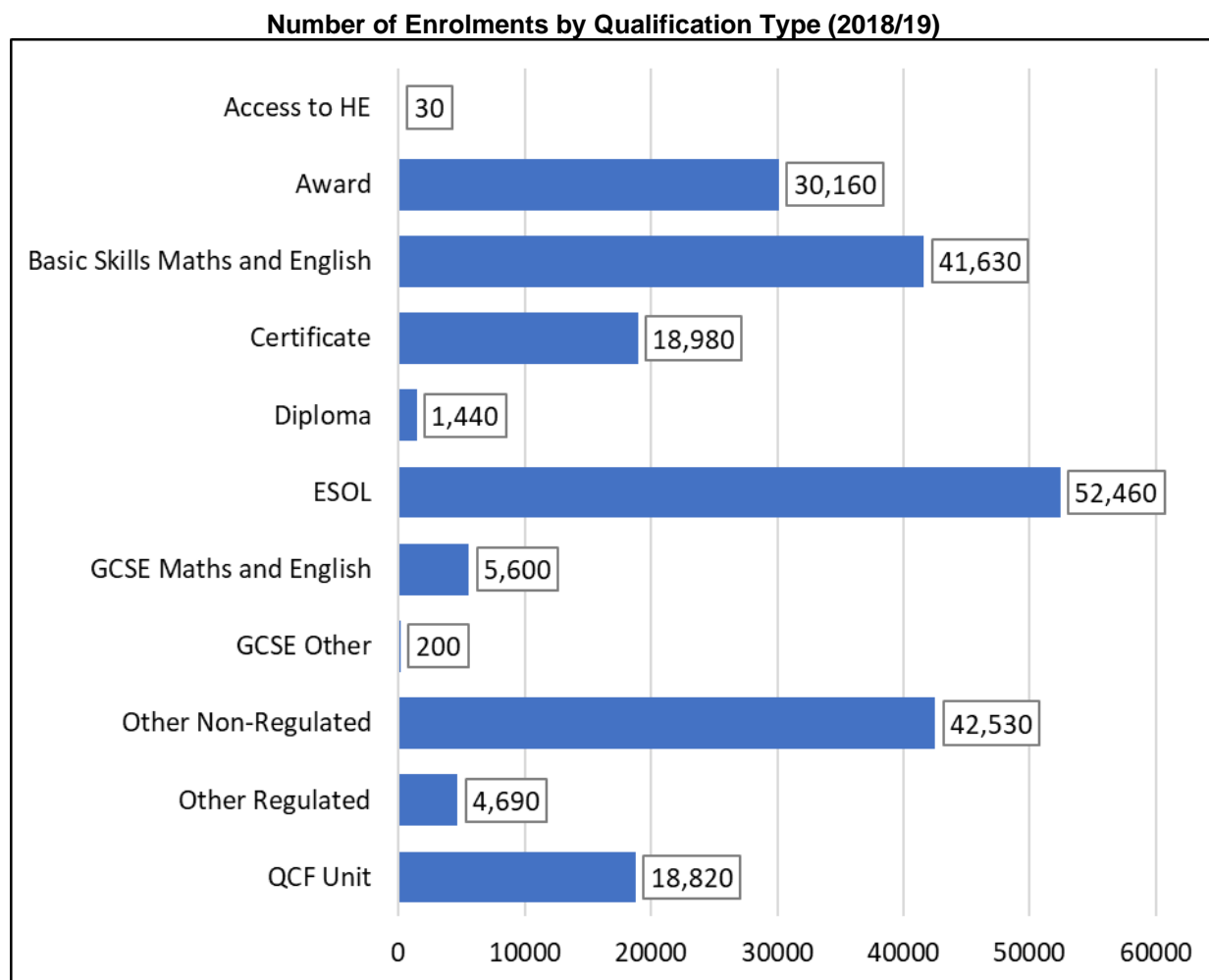

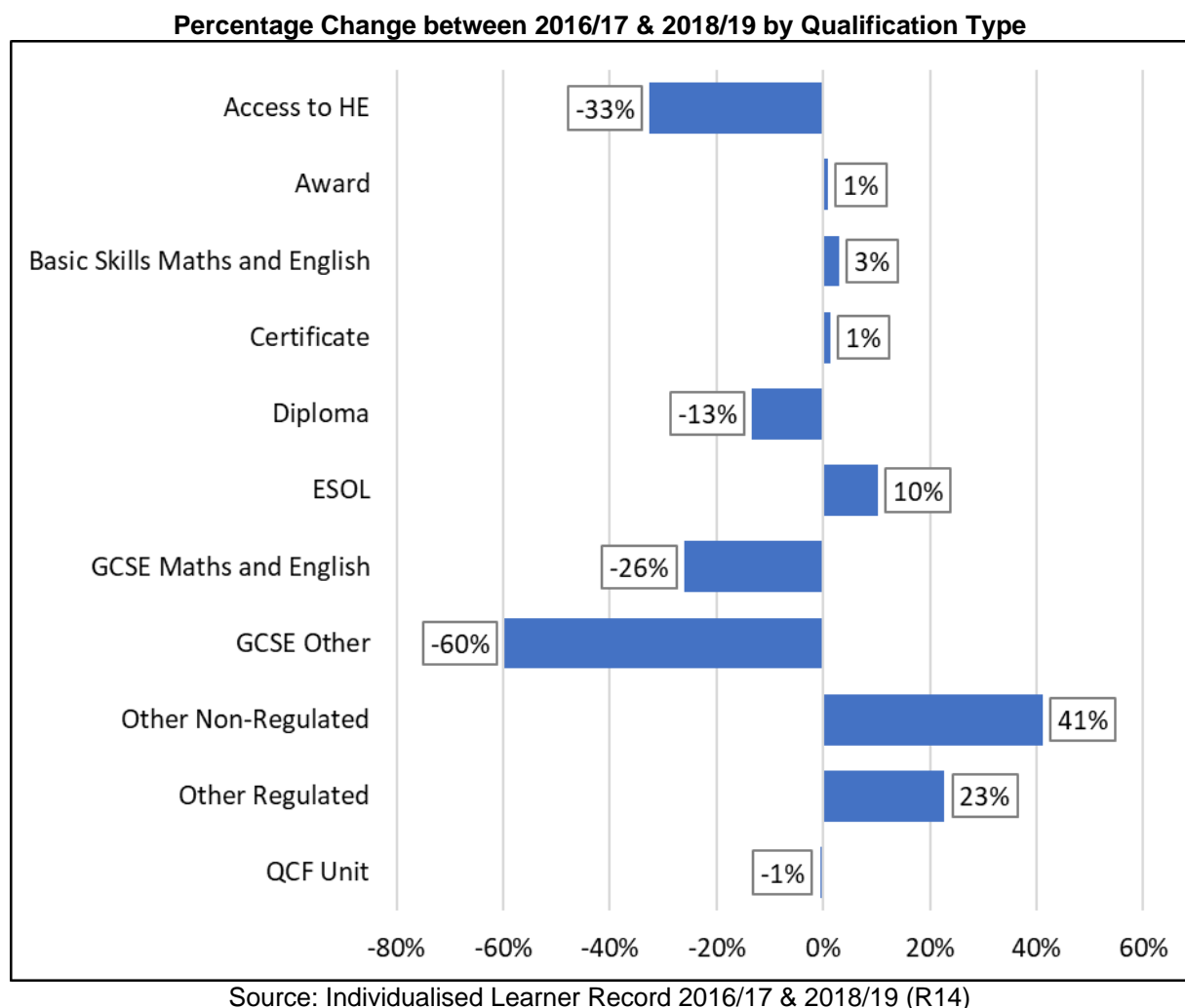

3.7 Qualification Type



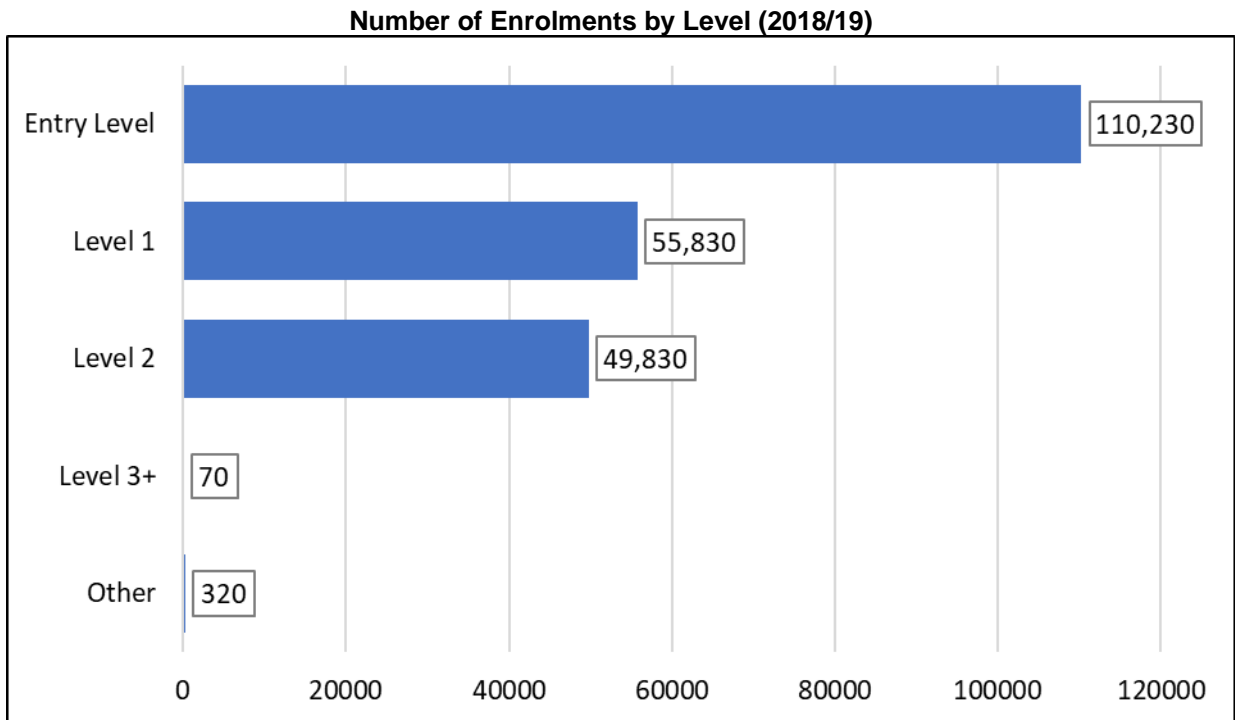

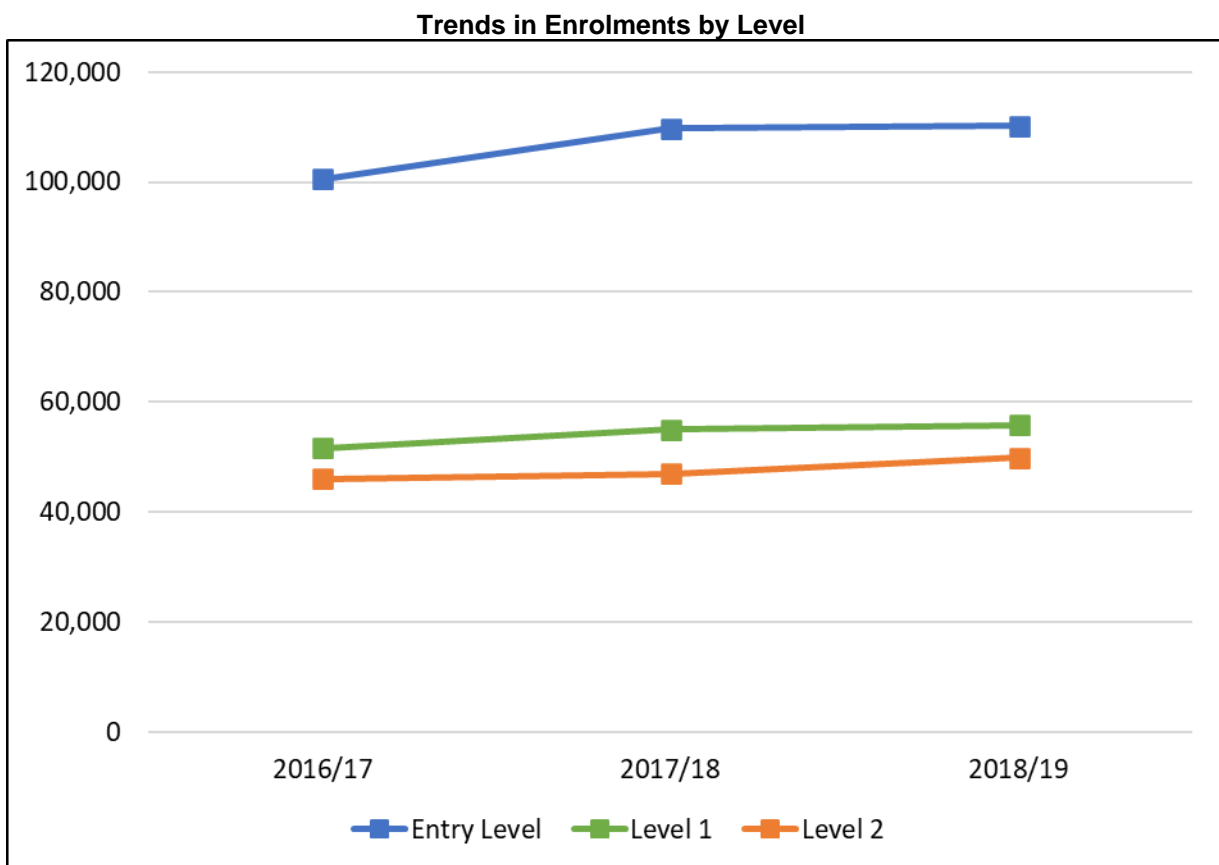

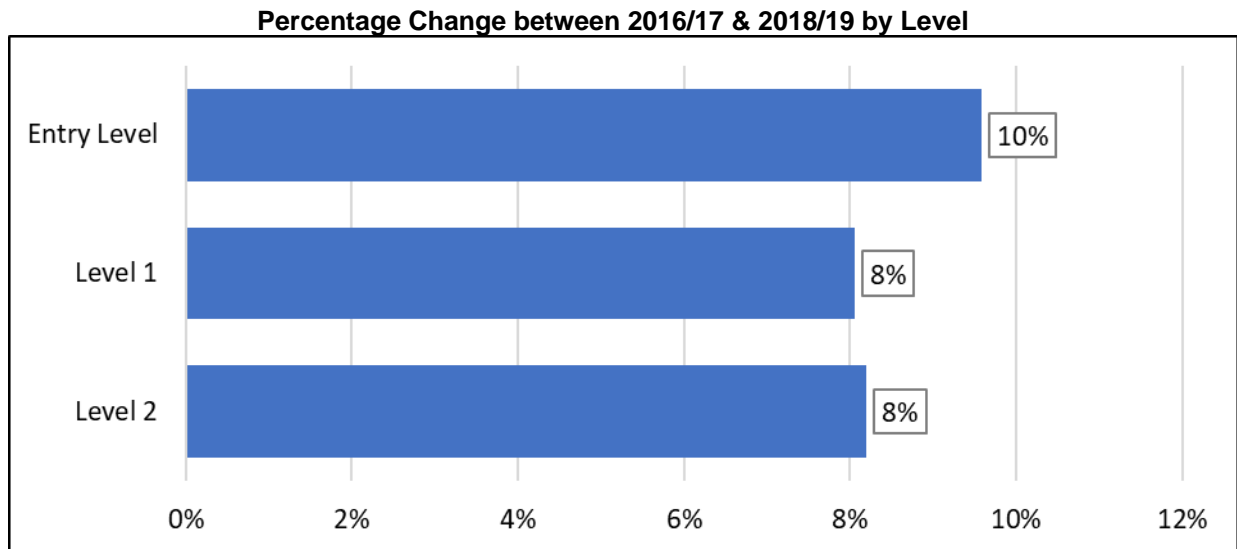

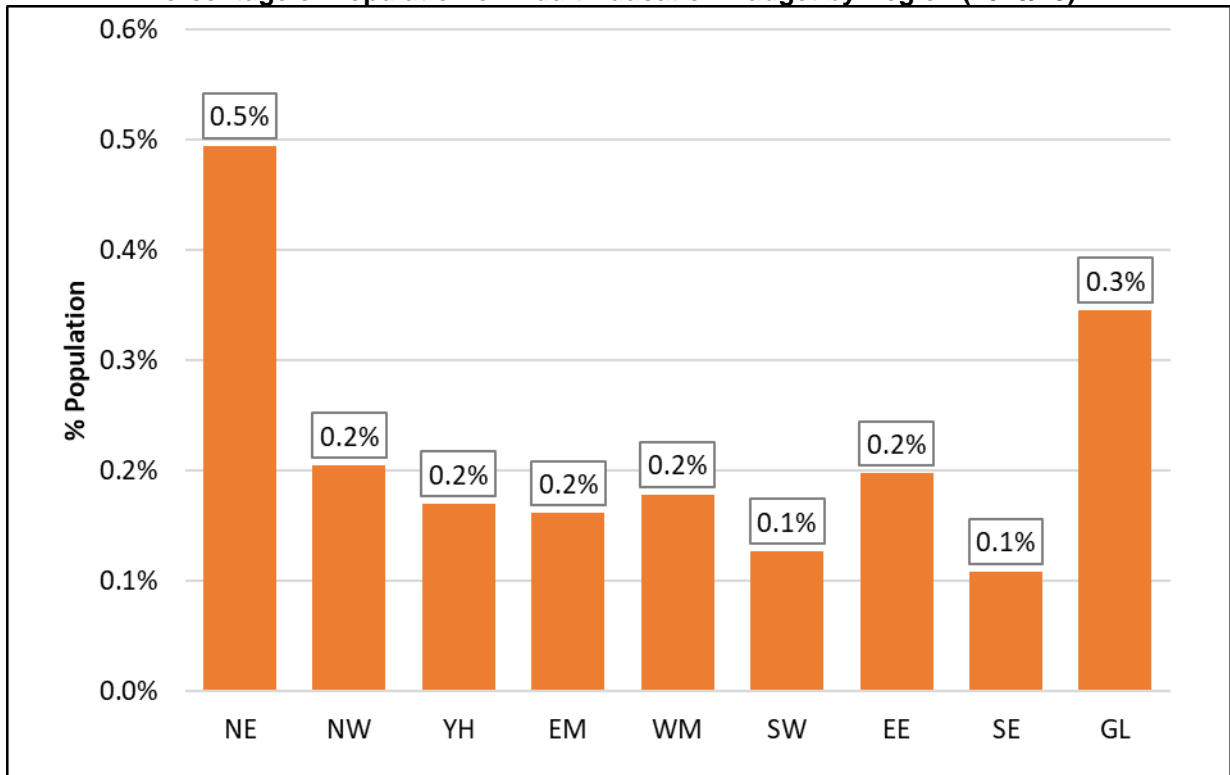

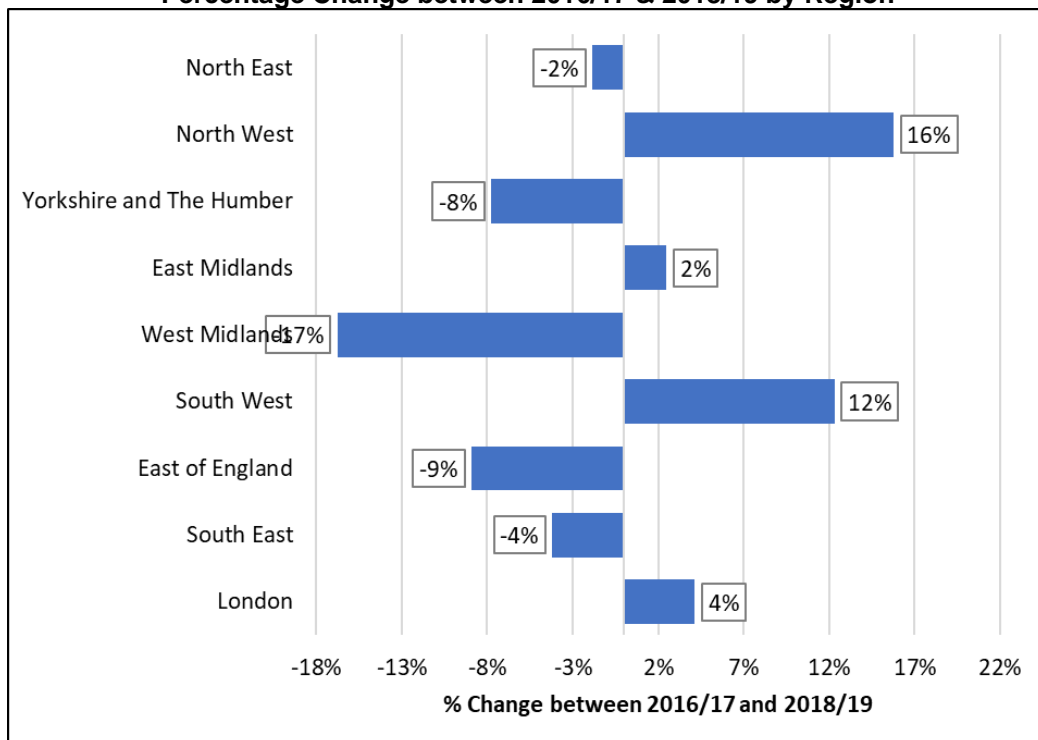
3.9 Learner Home Region

Percentage Change between 2016/17 & 2018/19 by Region

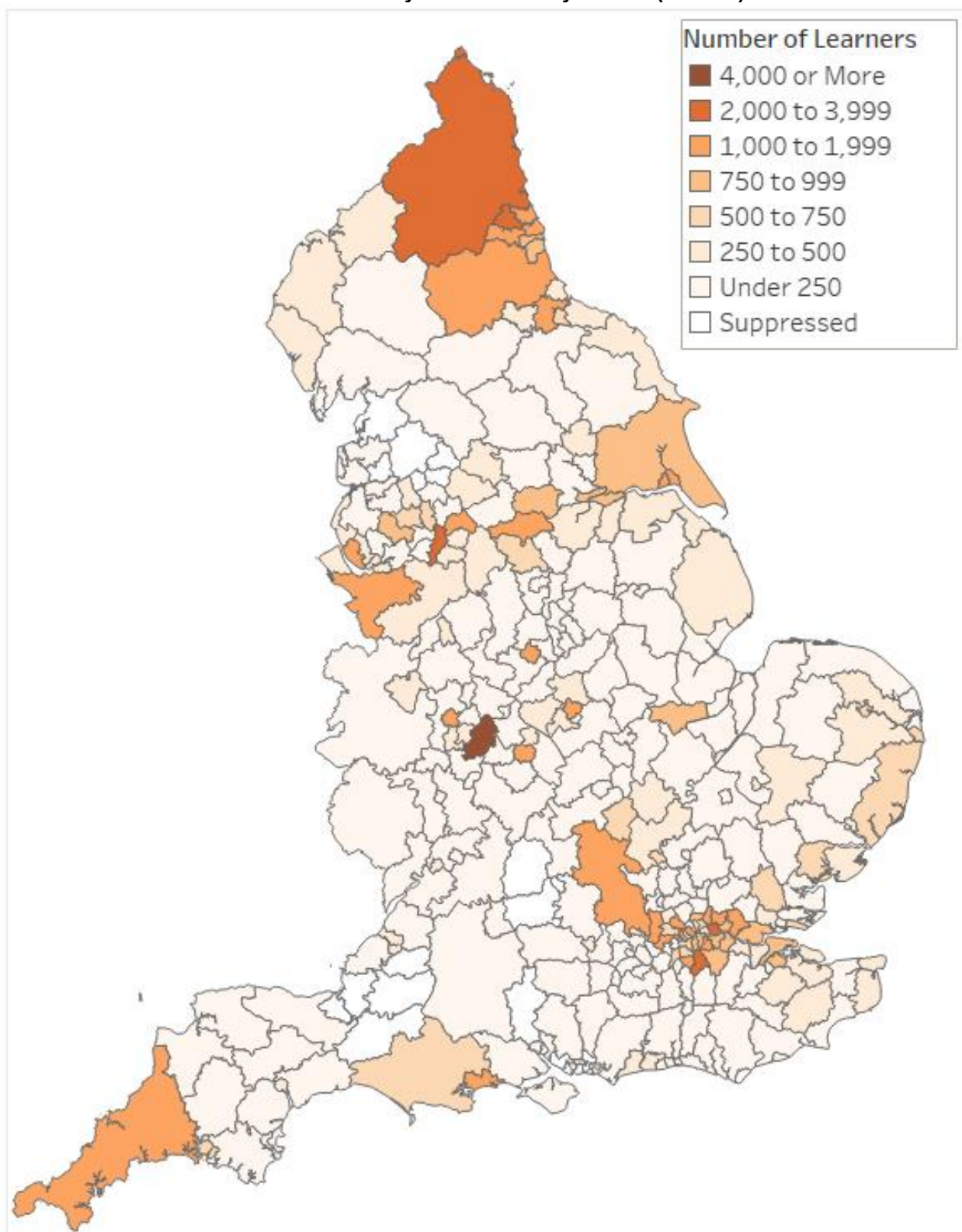

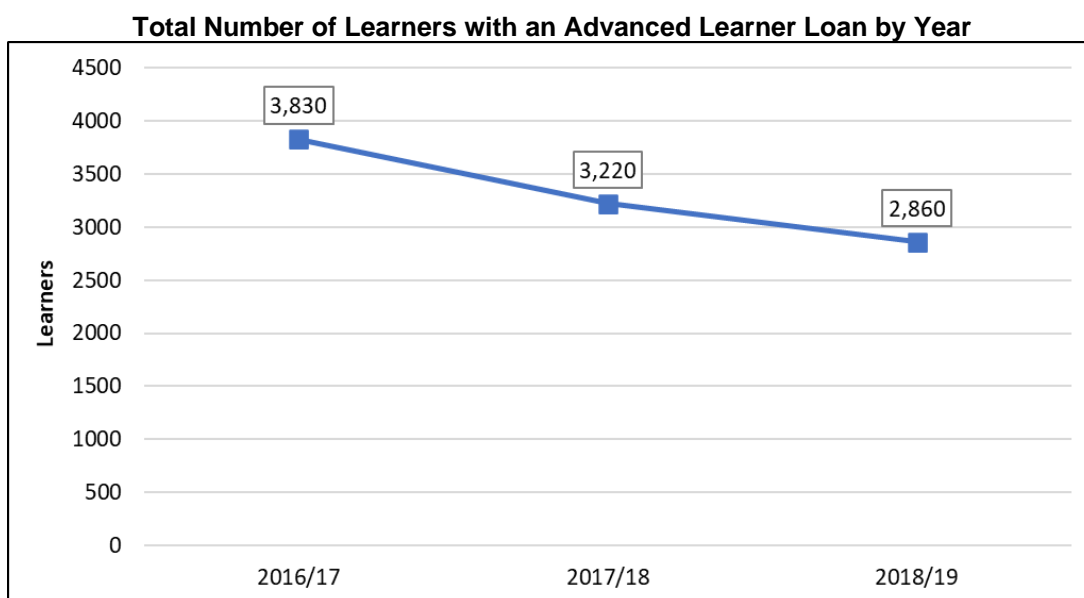

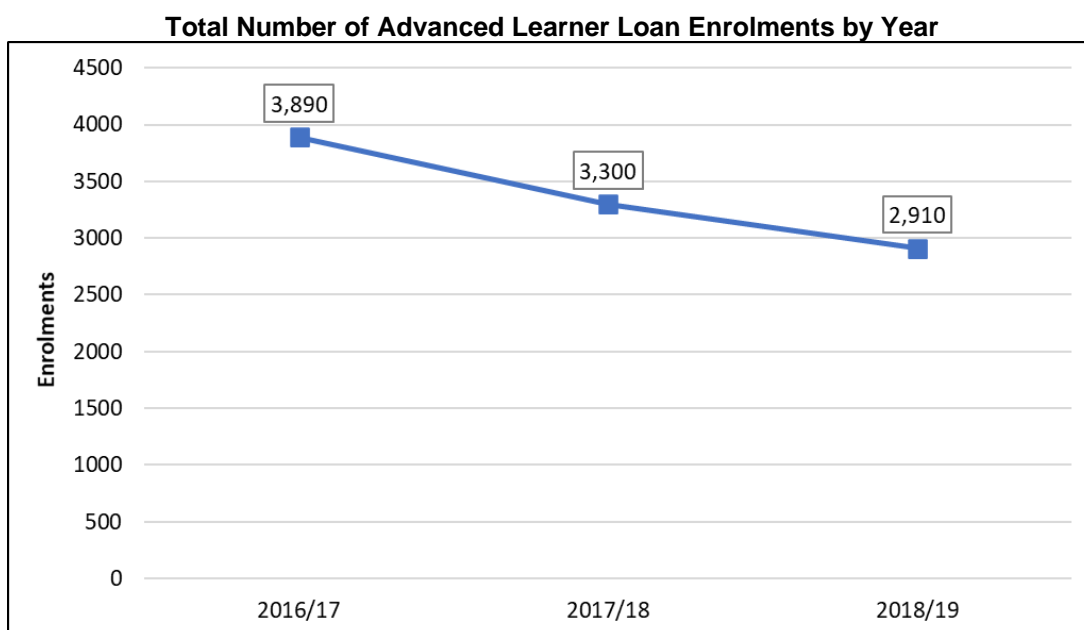

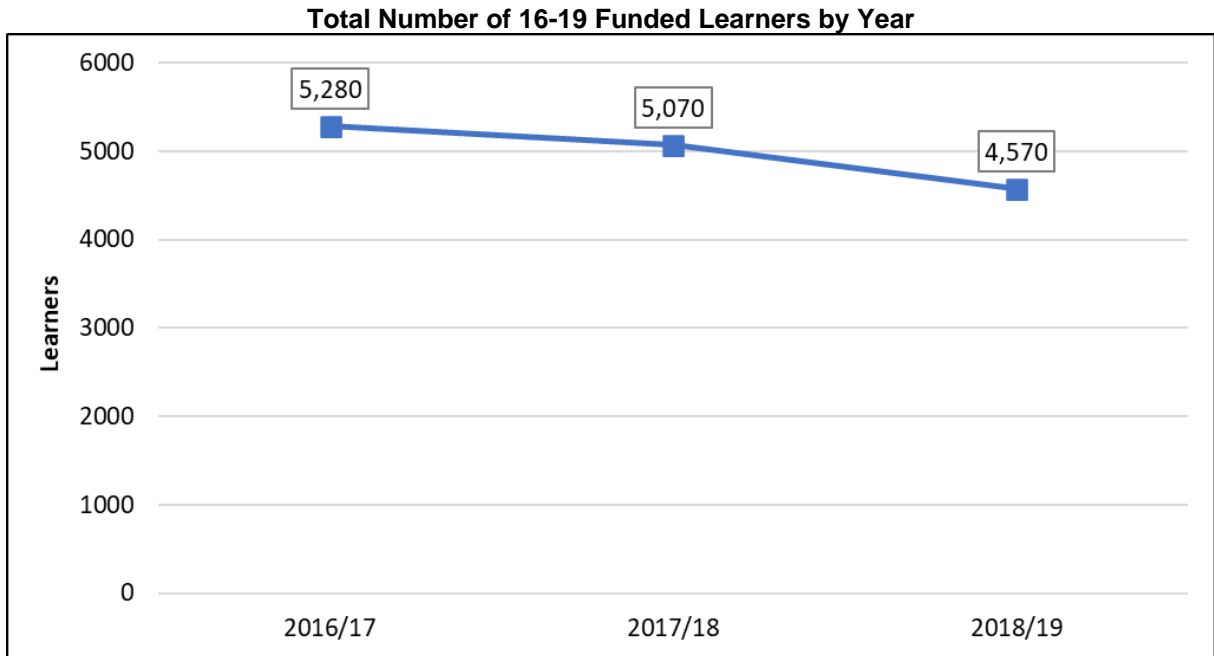

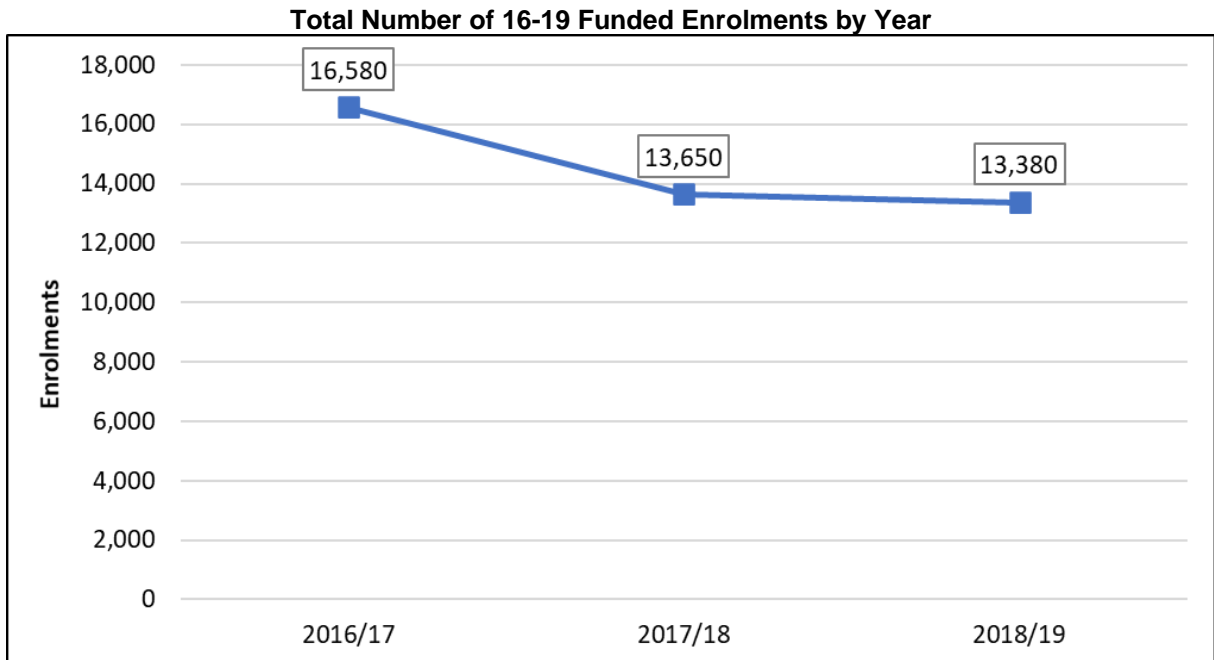

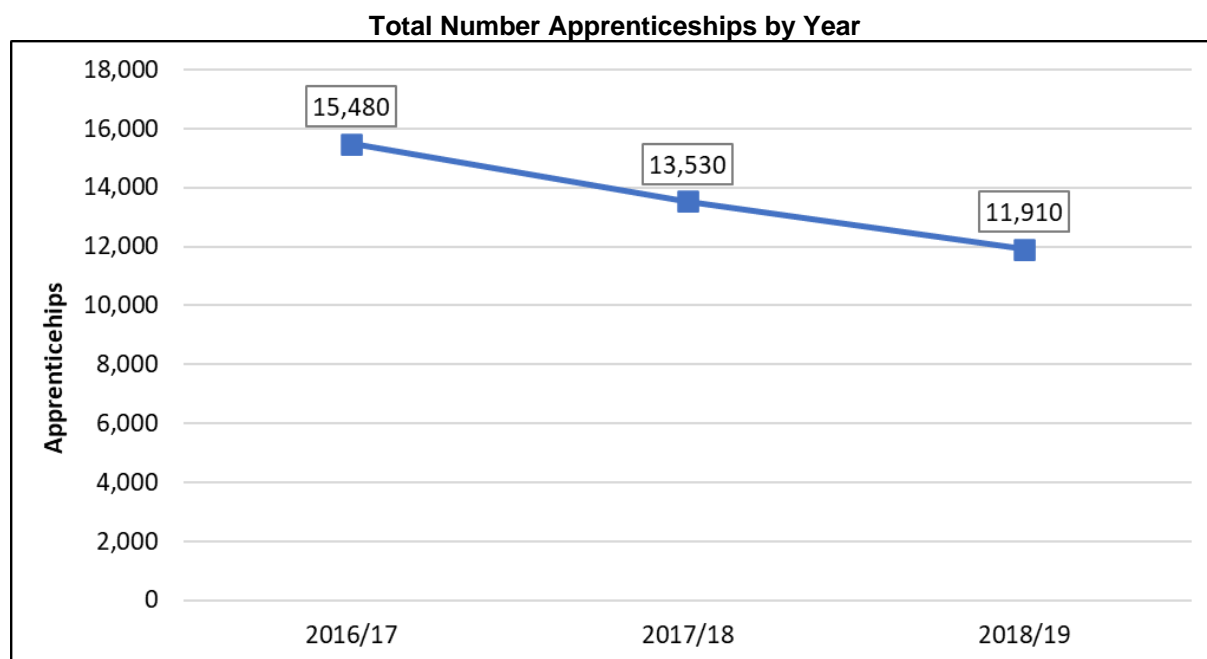
